This feast commemorates that she who was to bear the Incarnate Word of God was immaculate herself from the first moment of her conception.

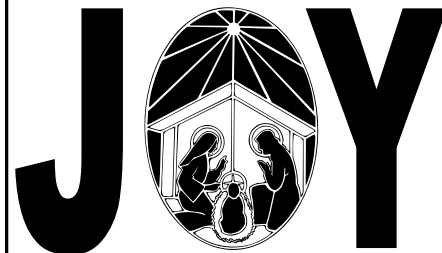
America turns to Our Lady under the title of the Immaculate Conception asking her intercession to watch over us and guide us along the path of justice and peace.

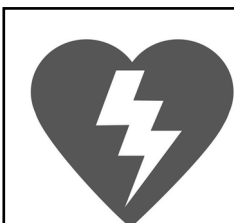
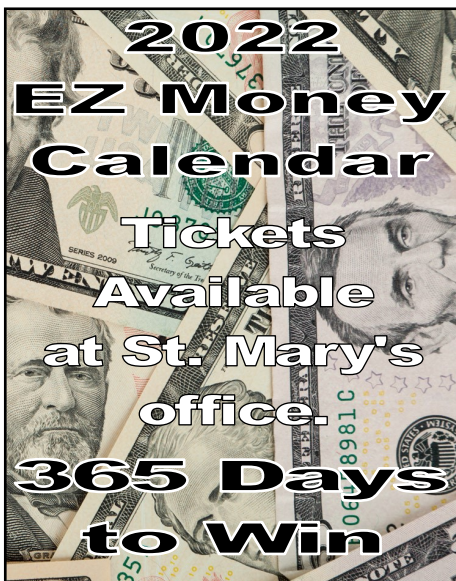
