On March 8th we will pray Mary's Way of the Cross at both locations. Women of the parish are needed to lead each station. If interested please contact either parish office soon.





Events in today's reading took place approximately 1800 years before Christ. In that pagan culture, child sacrifice was common. That's why Abraham believed God wanted him to sacrifice his only son Isaac. Later generations constantly looked back to this event as an example of Abra ham's great faith.


Second Reading: Romans 8:31-34


