

# **INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS**

#### **FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIMES**

**Deuteronomy 18:15-20** The events in today's reading take place as the Israelites are camped on the shore of the Jordan River ready to enter the Promised Land. Moses is near death and is giving final instructions. He promises that after his death, God will still be with them through another prophet. Both Jewish and Christian readers have seen this as referring to the future Messiah.

**1 Corinthians 7:32-35** In this section of the first letter to the Corinthians, Paul is responding to their question about whether it is better to remain single or become married. Paul's belief was that when you became Christian, you shouldn't take on a new state in life since he expected Jesus would return in glory soon.

# BLESSING OF THROATS

St. Blaise Day (February 3rd)

This year of 2021, as provided for in the Book of Blessings, n. 1628, the Blessing of throats is to be given to all who are gathered and not individually. The priest or deacon gives the blessing to all assembled by extending hands, without crossed candles, over the people while saying the prayer of blessing. Those together respond, Amen. In order to provide for more of the faithful to receive this sacramental, it is recommended that the Blessing of Throats be given in this manner at Masses on the weekends preceding and following February 3rd. Individual throat bless-≥ ings will not occur this year.

Dear Parish Families, In 2020, the Lenten 'Prayer Partner" project was successfully re-ignited after many years of dormancy. This Lenten activity originated with an effort of the Family Life Committee at St Mary Parish in 1997. It then blossomed into a coordinated program, merging both our Hollidaysburg Parishes, with the additional support of Father Gardner.

We will need your application by Wednesday, February 3, to allow the committee to match each member with a non-immediate family participant. We will then send your "Prayer Pal" partner information in a second mailer, before the start of Lent.
