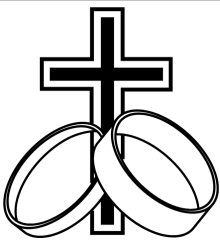
**Stewardship Reflection**

## The Historic Prince Gallitzin Chapel House

### Loretto



The historic Prince Gallitzin Chapel House, next to the Our Lady of the Alleghenies Shrine, will be open on the following Sunday afternoons from 3:00-6:00 PM for self-guided tours and visits: **This Sunday, June 20, July 18; and August 1, 15, and 29.**

The humble structure was the home and personal chapel of the Prince-Priest and Servant of God Demetrius Gallitzin. Today, it stands as a museum, which contains artifacts from Father Gallitzin's personal life.

## Patris Corde (With a Father's Heart)

### A Beloved Father, Pillar of Families

St. Joseph was a beloved father. St. Joseph placed himself at the service of his vocation as husband and father. Pope Francis in his apostolic letter *Patris Corde*, expressed it this way "He turned his human vocation to domestic love into a superhuman oblation of himself, his heart and all his abilities, a love placed at the service of the Messiah who was growing to maturity in his home."

Joseph makes his home into a small church in Nazareth, a village of about forty houses. Imagine Mary speaking to the women of her village around the well, praying the Psalms with Jesus and Joseph, blessing God at every simple meal, participating in the great pilgrimages, and learning by heart the principal blessings which begin thus, "blessed may you be, O Lord our God, King of the Universe" Let us each live our vocation faithfully.

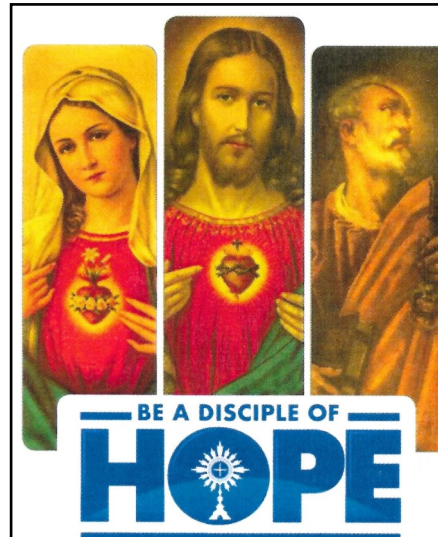
