
Praying for vocations is a vital part of our duty as Catholic adults. We need to encourage our youth to consider a vocation to the religious life.

A Beloved Father, **Pillar of Families**

St. Joseph was a beloved father. St. Joseph placed himself at the service of his vocation as husband and father. Pope Francis in his apostolic letter Patris Corde, expressed it this way "He turned his human vocation to domestic love into a superhuman oblation of himself, his heart and all his abilities, a love placed at the service of the Messiah who was growing to maturity in his home."

Joseph makes his home into a small church in Nazareth, a village of about forty houses. Imagine Mary speaking to the women of her village around the well, praying the Psalms with Jesus and Joseph, blessing God at every simple meal, participating in the great pilgrimages, and learning by heart the principal blessings which begin thus, "blessed may you be, O Lord our God, King of the Universe" Let us each live our vocation faithfully.


