Holy Tridium Masses

The summit of the Liturgical Year is the Easter Tridium—from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery.

The single celebration of the Tridium marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

The liturgical services that take place during the Tridium are:

Mass of the Lord's Supper

(Celebrated at St. Mary Church at 7 PM)

Good Friday of the Lord's Passion

(Celebrated at St. Mary Church at 3 PM)

Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord

(Vigil Mass Celebrated at St. Michael Church at 8:30 PM)

(Sunday: at St. Mary Church 7:30 and 10 AM
at St Michael Church 7:30, 10:00 and 11:30 AM)

These are the three most important days of the Catholic Church.

We are fortunate to have two strong parishes so close in proximity to each other. This allows us to easily follow what is stated in the Roman Missal:

THE SACRED PASCHAL TRIDIUM

1. In the Sacred Tridium, the Church solemnly celebrates the greatest mysteries of our redemption, keeping by means of special celebrations the memorial of her Lord, crucified, buried, and risen. The Paschal Fast should also be kept sacred. **It is to be celebrated everywhere on the Friday of the Lord's Passion and, where appropriate, prolonged also through Holy Saturday as a way of coming, with spirit uplifted, to the joys of the Lord's Resurrection.**

2. For a fitting celebration of the Sacred Tridium, a sufficient number of lay ministers is required, who must be carefully instructed as to what they are to do.

The singing of the people, the ministers, and the Priest Celebrant has a special importance in the celebrations of these days, for when texts are sung, they have their proper impact. Pastors should, therefore, not fail to explain to the Christian faithful, as best they can, the meaning and order of the celebrations and to prepare them for active and fruitful participation.

3. The celebrations of the Sacred Tridium are to be carried out in cathedral and parochial churches and only in those churches in which they can be performed with dignity, that is, with a good attendance of the faithful, an appropriate number of ministers, and the means to sing at least some of the parts.

Consequently, it is desirable that small communities, associations, and special groups of various kinds join together in these churches to carry out the sacred celebrations in a more noble manner. (Roman Missal, Third Typical Edition, 2011.)

Even though we currently have two priests we unfortunately do not have sufficient hospitality ministers (greeters), readers, extraordinary ministers of holy communion, cantors, altar servers, etc.. to justify the tridium being celebrated at both parishes, and as the missal states: smaller communities should join together for these celebrations. We are excited to be able to celebrate as a community combining our parishioners, liturgical ministers, musicians and priests.

Let us rejoice and be glad!

Bishop Mark will gather with his college of presbyters assisted by his deacons with the assembled faithful from throughout the Diocese. All are welcome to attend the Mass.

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS Passion Sunday (Palm Sunday)

First Reading: Isaiah 50:4-7

Chapters 40-55 of the Book of Isaiah contain the message of a prophet who spoke to God's people during their exile in Babylon. Several times the prophet speaks about a servant who will one day deliver God's people. Because the Servant is portrayed as suffering, Christians have traditionally identified Jesus with him.

Second Reading: Philippians 2:6-11

In the years following Christ's death and resurrection, Christians began to develop the prayers and hymns that would become part of their rituals. In today's passage from the letter to the Philippians, Paul appears to be quoting an early Christian hymn celebrating the dying and rising of Christ.
