




east of St. Anthony of Padua Celebration

The event will include an outdoor Mass, Blessing of St. Anthony's Bread, and Blessing with First Class Relic of St. Anthony.


St. Anthony Bread is a term used for offerings made in thanksgiving to God for blessings received through the prayers of St. Anthony.




