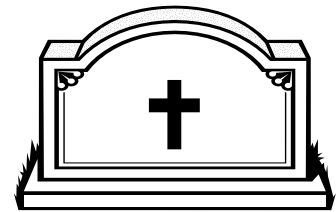


Bishop Mark will soon ordain Deacon Brian Norris to the priesthood.

**INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY’S READINGS
FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER**

First Reading: Acts 13:14, 43-52 None of the readings at liturgy during the seven-week Easter Season is from the Old Testament. In its place, we read from the Acts of the Apostles to show how the Easter message spread far and wide, to all parts of the Mediterranean world. Today, Paul and Barnabas are preaching in what is now central Turkey.

Second Reading: Revelation 7:9, 14-17 The book of Revelation was not intended to predict actual people and events in future times. The author was concerned only about people and events in his own time and was given no privileged information about the future. In this passage, the author encourages people of that time by presenting a vision of God’s people enjoying heavenly life.
