

# INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

First Sunday in Lent

**Genesis 2: 7-9; 3: 1-7** The account of the sin of Adam and Eve was composed as a classic example of how everyone sins. The author recognized that there was a standard pattern: We toy with temptation - we fall - then we make excuses.

**Romans 5: 12-19** Paul's letter to the Romans is his most detailed and important theological work. His purpose in this passage is not to teach about original sin, but to contrast Adam and Christ. From Adam we inherited a strong pull toward sin. From Christ (the "new Adam") we received a gift that is incomparably stronger: Divine Grace.

The Passion Accounts in the Gospels


end of the famine with a great feast hosted by the wealthy, to which all were invited, especially the sick and the poor.




