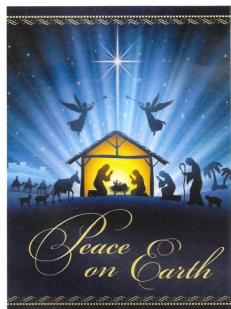

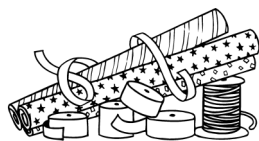

Rosary for the Priests in Your Life

Looking for a creative way to pray for the priests in your life? Pray the first decade for the priest who baptized you, the second decade for the priest who gave you First Communion, the third for the priest or bishop who confirmed you, the fourth for the priest who witnessed your marriage or religious vows, (or the bishop who ordained you), and the fifth for the priest who will anoint you before death.

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: 2 Maccabees 7: 1-2, 9-14 The two books of Maccabees describe a period of persecution suffered by the Jews about 150 years before Christ. At that time, they were a nation subject to Syria whose king tried to force them to abandon their religious customs. Today's passage describes the resistance of one family, whose bravery became legendary.

Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 2: 16, 3:5 The two letters to the Thessalonians were addressed to a Christian community founded by Paul early in his missionary travels. Thessalonica was located in the northern portion of modern-day Greece. Early Christians believed that Jesus would return soon; these letters address how they ought to live as they await that coming.



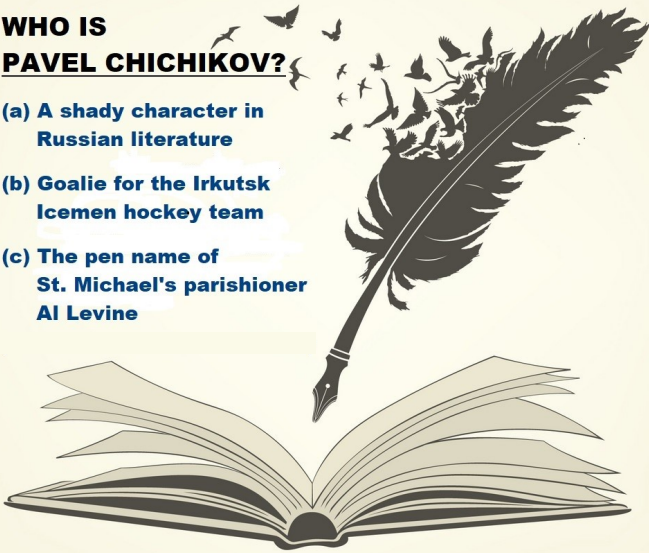
