

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS TWENTY- NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Isaiah 45: 1, 4-6 When today's passage from the book of Isaiah was written, the Jewish people had been held in exile by Babylon for more that 40 years. Cyrus, the king of neighboring Persia, was preparing to invade Babylon. The prophet sees Cyrus, a pagan king, as an instrument of God. Through this military victory, God will free his people and allow them to return home.

Second Reading: 1 Thessalonians 1: 1-5 Paul's first letter to the Thessalonians is the earliest of all New Testament writings, coming only about 20 years after the Resurrection of Jesus. Today's reading gives us the letter's opening words. In just five verses, we hear reference to God the Father, the Lord Jesus and the Holy Spirit, and also to faith, hope and love. It indicates how quickly these essentials of our faith became part of our Christian tradition.
