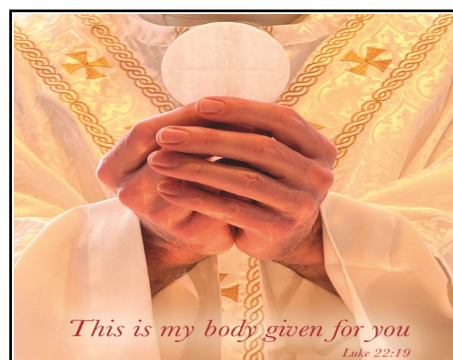
Night of Worship THIS Tuesday, September 20th Praise & Worship

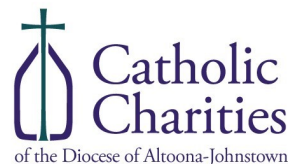
