1 Timothy 6: 11-16 In the latter years of the first century, when first letter to Timothy was written, Church leaders were concerned that Christianity not be seen as opposed to the good order of society. So, today's passage pictures Paul exhorting one of his companions, Timothy, to lead an upright life.
