INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29 The book of Sirach was written by a wise teacher who lived 200 years before Christ. Sirach ran a school for young people in Jerusalem. In today's section, he gives his students a string of wise sayings to guide them in their conduct.

Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24a In today's reading from the letter to the Hebrews, the author contrasts two covenants. He begins with the covenant at Mount Sinai, which was ratified amid fire and darkness. The he speaks of the new covenant established by Jesus at Mount Zion (which is another name for Jerusalem).
