Stewardship Reflection
The Blessed Virgin Mary, is not only the model Christian disciple but also the model Christian steward. Mary had heard the word of God; she believed it; and she observed in her willingness to obey. "May it be done according to your word," she said to the angel (Luke 1:38), accepting the vocation God had prepared for her. Her vocation shows us the pattern of a good steward. She offered her time to

steward. She offered her time to spend with her divine Son at his birth, in the years of his youth, at his death, and at prayer with the Apostles after the Ascension. She gave talent when she offered a mother's care.

What earthly treasure she possessed was of secondary importance compared to her service to God. Her desire for material security was not enough to keep her from fleeing to Egypt with Joseph to protect their Son or to stop her from coming to Jerusalem for his Crucifixion. he Barbara Zanker Fund The Barbara Zanker Fund was established by the will of Barbara Zanker who passed away in the year 1898. Barbara and her husband Joseph, were members and great benefactors of St. Michael Parish. In 1878, the year a two story school was to be built near the corner of Pine & Montgomery Streets, Barbara Zanker furnished the \$4,000.00 that was needed to build the school. (That school was demolished around 1990.)


Mrs. Zanker's interests in the school did not end in aiding in it's erection as in her Last Will and Testament she specified that the residue of her entire estate should form a perpetual trust fund, the revenue thereof from its investments to be used for the maintenance of St. Michael's School. Over the past 122+ years the Barbara Zanker Fund has grown from many large and small contributions and bequests. Since it's creation, the fund has given several hundred of thousand dollars to St. Michael's School, renamed Hollidaysburg Catholic and now known as Holy Trinity Catholic School -Hollidaysburg Campus.

Recently the trustees gave the parish \$7,000.00 to help keep the school running. We are grateful for the generosity of Mrs. Zanker, for those who continue to invest into the Zanker Fund, for the trustees, and for all who pray and help financially support Catholic education. 

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS Feast of the Assumption

Revelation 11:19, 12:1-6a, 10ab The book of Revelation was written about 95 A.D. to encourage people who were suffering persecution. It is written in symbolic language and uses many images – for example, a dragon to represent evil. In today's reading, the Church is depicted as a woman giving birth to the Messiah. As the years went by, this imagery was extended to Mary.

1 Corinthians 15:20-27 In his first letter to the Corinthians, Paul addresses problems his converts in the community were experiencing. Some members of the community had questioned the bodily resurrection of Jesus, and their own resurrection as well. This passage is Paul's response.
