

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

THE EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Isaiah 55: 1-3 Today's reading is from a part of the book of Isaiah written when the Jewish people were exiled in Babylon. This section is often referred to as the "book of comfort" because of the encouragement it gives. Today's passage is a glorious finale to this "book of comfort": Poor people are being invited to a sumptuous banquet.

Romans 8: 35, 37-39 Today's reading concludes the eighth chapter of Paul's letter to the Romans. This chapter reflects on the salvation brought about by God in and through Jesus. Paul concludes this chapter with a jubilant hymn that celebrates the love of God expressed in Christ.

Next Sunday's Readings: 1 Kings 19:9a, 11 – 13a and Romans 9:1-5; Gospel: Matthew 14:22-23

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

The disciples in today's gospel looked to Jesus to feed the thousands of people in the crowds and he told them, "There is no need for them to go away; give them some food yourselves." When the disciples claimed they did not have enough with only the small amount of five loaves and two fish among themselves, Jesus challenged them to be personally responsible and not allow them to abandon the crowd in their time of need.

The simple gifts accepted by Jesus were given in an act of love and trust. No matter how small or limited our gifts seem we must personally share them with generosity. God will make what we offer "enough." Simple gifts were "multiplied." During the past six months we have witnessed thousands of men, women, and children being the giver of simple gifts to the "crowds" throughout our country and beyond who are in very extreme circumstances and levels of need. Will we share our simple gifts of "loaves and fishes" as a habit and not wait for someone else to step forward first?

It's time to register your child for this year's Religious Education Program! We are ready to help teach your child our Catechesis and to enrich their faith. All students (Pre K–11) MUST register even if in the program last year. Students who attend HTCS or BGHS, and are in our sacramental prep years (2nd grade and 9 - 11th grade), must also register. If you choose to homeschool your child, we encourage you to use the books we use in the classroom so that we can assist you with this endeavor.

Whichever way you choose, homeschooling or in classroom learning, we ask that you register your child on-line **before August 15** (via our parish website) and participate in our first Drive Thru to pick-up books and other items to facilitate your families' faith formation

<u>On Saturday, August 15</u>th we will be holding our first ever **Drive-Thru Faith Formation Pick-Up Event.** This will be a fun, safe, and faith-filled event for the whole family. We will have your faith formation material for September through November packaged and ready for you to take home and get started.
