

# **INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS**

#### FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**First Reading: Isaiah 55: 10-11** Because the Israelites were exiled in the pagan land of Babylon, the assuring words that God had previously spoken to them now seemed empty. In today's passage, the prophet Isaiah will use an image from nature to describe how God's word always bears fruit and comes true no matter how unlikely it may seem.

**Second Reading: Romans 8: 18-23** As we continue reading from chapter eight of Paul's letter to the Romans, he tells us that sin affected not only human beings but also all creation, and the coming of Christ had a healing effect on *both*. It is evident that Paul is not pessimistic about this world.

Next Sunday's Readings: Wisdom 12: 13, 16-19 and Romans 8: 26-27; Gospel: Matthew 13:24-43
