

## INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**First Reading: Wisdom 12: 13, 16-19** The book of Wisdom was written about 50 years before Christ. In one lengthy section of this book, the author looks back to the wonderful things God did for the Jewish people during the exodus. In today's passage from that section, the author speaks directly to God with words of praise.

**Second Reading: Romans 8: 26-27** We continue to read from the eighth chapter of the letter to the Romans, in which Paul discusses the role of God's Spirit in our life. Today's brief reading gives us a remarkable insight into prayer.

## STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Like the mustard bush that began with the "smallest of all the seeds, yet when full-grown and the largest of the plants," (Mt 13: 32) we can all become children of the Kingdom.

Stewardship is most deeply about pleasure and increase. When you are generous you are doing something that makes a difference in someone's life and that does make you feel good. "Stewardship is already in your heart. There is something deep within us that is good and generous, some almost biological sensation that is triggered when we see a need.
