INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading:1 Kings 3: 5, 7-12 King Solomon ruled about 950 years before Christ. His wisdom was legendary. Today's reading describes an event from early in Solomon's rule that tells how he became a wise person.

Second Reading: Romans 8: 28-30 As we continue reading from the eighth chapter of Paul's letter to the Romans, we will hear Paul use the word *predestined*. This word does not mean that individuals are locked into a destiny over which they have no control. Rather, it means that in Christ, God provides abundant grace for everyone.

Next Sunday's Readings: Isaiah 55:1-3 and Romans 8:35,37-39; Gospel: Matthew: 14:13-21
