

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

PENTECOST SUNDAY

Acts 2: 1-11 Pentecost was a Jewish feast that celebrated the beginning of the harvest. It took place 50 days after the feast of Passover. Jewish pilgrims came to Jerusalem from all over the ancient world for the celebration. Today we hear how Pentecost became a Christian feast.

1 Corinthians 12: 3-7, 12-13 Paul's first letter to the Corinthians responds to a letter they wrote to him, asking how to deal with the diversity of gifts in the community, and the rivalries and jealousies that inevitably arose. In today's passage, he uses a comparison that we will recognize immediately.

THE CHURCH DOORS ARE OPEN FOR VISITATION AND PRIVATE PRAYER

Following the directives from Bishop Mark, we have reopened the church for daily visitation and private prayer. Please recognize that there are potential risks of unintended exposure to the coronavirus, please refrain from visiting if you are sick. The church doors will be open from: (subject to change)

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

For the reopening of the church we will need the help of **many** volunteers. Please read over the specific needs listed below to discern where and how you may be able to help:

Ministers of Hospitality: We will need multiple Ministers of Hospitality at all weekend Masses. They will be trained to help assist in seating people in compliance with the six-foot rule and keep people spaced apart during Holy Communion. They'll also distribute bulletins at the end of Mass. If you had previously been an usher, and you're willing to take the risk of coming to weekend Masses, then we could really use your help. Obviously new volunteers will also be needed. There will be two training sessions for ministers of hospitality. The first will be on Saturday, June 6, at 10:00 am at St. Mary's Church. The second will be Saturday, June 13, at 10:00 am at St. Michael's Church. Because the procedures will be similar at both parishes, you can come to either training session.

<u>Volunteers to help clean pews</u>: We need multiple volunteers to help clean the church between weekend Masses. Pews will need to be sprayed and wiped down, door handles cleaned and so on. Please contact the parish office if you would be willing to perform this work of charity. Be sure to let us know which Mass you will normally be attending.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion: We will also need a sufficient number of extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion. We'll need help at Mass itself. Communion will be under the form of bread only, but it's helpful to have a second minister at Mass. It will also be helpful if ministers of Holy Communion can be available to help distribute Communion after Mass. More importantly, though, we're going to need people who are willing to take Holy Communion to the sick, the fearful, the homebound, and anyone who is unable to come to the church. If you have family members in these conditions, perhaps you'd be willing to volunteer. Training sessions for all who choose to continue as ministers of Holy Communion as well as those who would like to take on this ministry will be on Saturday, June 6, at 11:00 am at St. Mary's Church, and Saturday, June 13, at 11:00 am at St. Michael's Church. Again, because of similar procedures, you can attend either session. If you'd like to participate in this important work but these times don't work for you, give the parish office acall to arrange for a private training session.


