



Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time Malachi 3: 19-20 The book of Malachi was written after the Jews returned from exile in Babylon. Faced with the problems on all sides, many in the community doubted whether God would ever again act on their behalf. In today's passage, Malachi responds to these skeptics.

2 Thessalonians 3: 7-12 Second Thessalonians addresses concerns early Christians had about the coming of Christ in glory. Some were excessively interested in the day and hour of Christ's coming. Others thought that his imminent coming was an invitation to idleness.




First Reconciliation for 2nd Grade Students Saturday, December 10th


