INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS

TWENTY - THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Ezekiel 33: 7-9 Ezekiel was an Old Testament prophet who ministered to the Jewish people exiled in Babylon. In today's passage, the speaker is God who uses the image of a watchman to describe a prophet's role. In those times, a watchman was someone who stood on a hill or in a tower to watch for invaders.

Second Reading: Romans 13: 8-10 In the concluding section of his letter to the Romans, Paul writes about the moral demands of Christian life. This letter was written some years before the Gospels, yet these words will sound very much like words we hear in the Gospels. Clearly, Paul is drawing upon a pre-Gospel tradition about what Jesus said.


