

The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist and sent out in mission "for the life of the world."

The Eucharistic Revival will launch in dioceses around the country on Sunday, June 19 – the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

Here in Altoona-Johnstown, a special diocesan celebration is planned in Loretto on that day. Eucharistic Adoration will be offered from 3:00-6:30 p.m. inside the Basilica of Saint Michael the Archangel. During those hours, various priests will also be available to hear Confessions. Then, Bishop Mark will celebrate a special outdoor Mass at 7:00 p.m. at the Our Lady of the Alleghenies Shrine next to the Basilica, followed by an outdoor Eucharistic Procession around the Shrine. If it is raining, the Mass will be celebrated inside the Basilica.

For the June 19 Mass, the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown is extending a special invitation to students who received their First Holy Communion this Easter season to be present with their families at the Mass and procession. Newly confirmed are also invited, along with those who entered full communion in the Catholic Church at Easter.

Ctewardship Reflection

In the Gospel from Saint John, we learn that God holds back nothing of Himself to us. Jesus tells His disciples that the Holy Spirit "will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything the Father has is mine."

What, then, should the response be of the Christian steward to this mystery? All we can do is worship and offer our lives back to God in total gratitude for calling us to live in the richness of such unfathomable love.

This week, let's re-invite God into the very middle of our lives and make sure the way we spend our time and energy each day shows Him our gratitude for His many gifts to us, but above all the gifts of Himself in the Trinity, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Proverbs 8: 22-31 The book of Proverbs is mostly a collection of wise sayings to help people live a good life. Today's passage from Proverbs, however, is a hymn to Wisdom which in the Old Testament is sometimes symbolically described as a person coming from God.

Romans 5: 1-5 Paul's letter to the Romans is his most detailed and important theological work. The Church chose this brief passage to be read on Trinity Sunday because, in these five verses, all three persons of the Trinity are mentioned.
