This Sunday Eucharistic Revival This Sunday, June 19th

The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist and sent out in mission "for the life of the world."

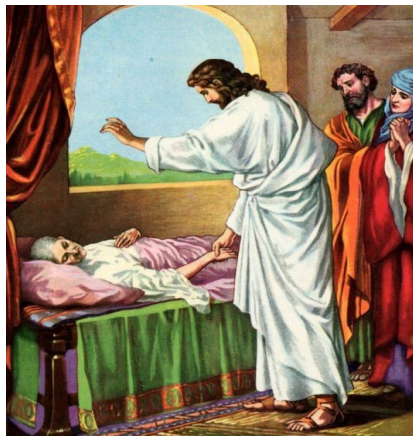
The Eucharistic Revival will launch in dioceses around the country on Sunday, June 19 – the Solemnity of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

Here in Altoona-Johnstown, a special diocesan celebration is planned in Loretto on that day. Eucharistic Adoration will be offered from 3:00-6:30 p.m. inside the Basilica of Saint Michael the Archangel. During those hours, various priests will also be available to hear Confessions. Then, Bishop Mark will celebrate a special outdoor Mass at 7:00 p.m. at the Our Lady of the Alleghenies Shrine next to the Basilica, followed by an outdoor Eucharistic Procession around the Shrine. If it is raining, the Mass will be celebrated inside the Basilica.



For the June 19 Mass, the Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown is extending a special invitation to students who received their First Holy Communion this Easter season to be present with their families at the Mass and procession. Newly confirmed are also invited, along with those who entered full communion in the Catholic Church at Easter.

INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ

Genesis 14: 18-20 Today's reading from the book of Genesis tells us all that we know about an obscure king named Melchizedek. Abraham had just won a military victory, and Melchizedek honors him with a meal of bread and wine. Over the course of time, this meal was seen as a distant foreshadowing of the Eucharist.

1 Corinthians 11: 23-26 The first letter to the Corinthians was written about 25 years after Christ's death and resurrection. Today's passage contains our earliest written account of what Jesus did at the Last Supper. This reading predates even the Gospels.
