



# Sanctuary Lamp or Vigil Light

At all Catholic Churches, there is an oil lamp or wax candle, known as the Sanctuary Lamp, it is continuously aglow above or near the tabernacle. It is a symbol that Christ is present in the Blessed Sacrament.



The Sanctuary lamp is only extinguished on Good Friday when the Body of Christ is removed from the main church and relit at Easter week the Vigil Mass.

In the past it was a tradition at St. Mary parish to have the candle burn in memory of a loved one. Since the sanctuary candle should be for the intentions of all members of the parish, the tradition of individual intentions will not be continuing as of July 1st.

At both parishes there are individual candles called Votive Candles or Prayer Candles. Those candles may be lit in the church for your intentions. Lighting a candle serves to prolong prayer beyond our presence in church. The candle remains behind and symbolizes the desire for prayer to continue. When we light candles in prayer, our intentions remain present even when we are gone. If you can not get to the church to light a candle you may ask the parish office to have one lit for you. The next time you pass a candle rack, help prolong others' prayers by offering one for the intentions of the people who lit them. A donation of \$5 is asked to help defray the cost of the candle.




## INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

**1 Kings 19: 16, 19-21** Elijah lived about 800 years before Jesus and was revered as the greatest prophet in Jewish history, although we have none of his writings. In today's passage, he is nearing the end of his life, and God instructs him to anoint a successor.

**Galatians 5: 1, 13-18** Some time after Paul had preached the Gospel there, other Christians came who insisted that to be a good Christian, one also had to follow the Jewish law and be circumcised. This caused great dissension in the Church there. In today's passage, Paul reaffirms their freedom from the law and pleads for greater harmony.
