### Stewardship Reflection

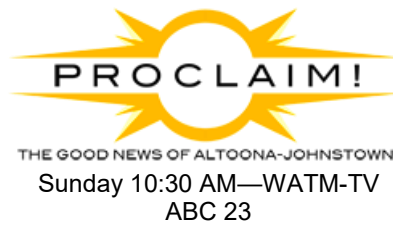

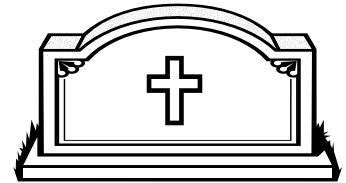
## With Many Thanks!

## **INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS The Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

**Ezekiel 2:2-5** Today's passage describes the call of the prophet Ezekiel. He was a Jewish priest who was deported to Babylon at the time of the exile. He is called to proclaim God's Word to those who are exiled with him. God warns him that this will be no easy task.

**2 Corinthians 12:7-10** Paul's whole ministry was beset not only by his own weakness but also by mistreatment and stress. In the passage just preceding today's reading, Paul described some of his spiritual visions. But in today's passage, he chooses not to boast of these but rather to talk about how God has worked through him despite his weakness.
