



Teen-to-do-List

After the Parent and Teen meeting at your church:

1. Fill in the **"Am I Ready to Be Confirmed "** self-inventory guide in a prayerful place.
2. Use the summer time to talk to your Mom, Dad, Guardian and your godparent or an older brother or sister who is a practicing Catholic about the decision you are making.
3. Make your decision!
4. Write a simple letter to your Pastor/administrator. Introduce yourself, tell him a little about yourself, where you go to school, how old you, and most importantly why you feel you are ready to be Confirmed. Your answers from the **"Am I ready to be Confirmed?"** guide for you could be helpful for you. Mail your letter, or bring it to the parish office in the summer or by a date the parish gives before school starts.

If it is hard for you to write a letter you can ask your Mom or Dad to please make an appointment with the Pastor to tell him in person. They can go with you.

5. Use the resources for choosing a sponsor and your confirmation name. Complete the **Commitment to Discipleship Form** and start to plan your service project.
6. Plan to go to the parish meeting that is scheduled in the fall and bring your **Commitment to Discipleship** form with you. If you have your service project proposal ready bring that also.

7. MARK YOUR CALENDARS with the Save-a-Dates the parish will give you for:

(in addition to Religious Education or your Catholic School schedule)

- **2 Discipleship Events**
- **Teen and Mentor Time**
- **Candidate and Sponsor Time/Reflection on Rite of Confirmation, Confession**
- **Confirmation Mass Rehearsal**
- **Confirmation Mass**

8. Finish planning your service project, submit your finished proposal, get started and keep working until it's done!
