Take a look at the personal faith inventory below and check what may apply to you. This will help guide you to know whether or not you are ready to formally begin the Confirmation process! Your answers will help you write your letter to your pastor.

- _____ I personally believe in God, and I would like my relationship with Him to be stronger now and in the future.
- _____ I do pray to God now and would like to grow in my ability to pray.
- _____ I believe that the Catholic Church is the one church established by Jesus, and that living as a disciple of Jesus means living as a faithful Catholic during my life.
- _____ I attend Mass every Sunday and have a desire to receive Holy Communion because I believe that the Eucharist is truly Christ's own Body.
- _____ If I do not attend Mass every Sunday, I know that it must become a priority for me.
- _____ I know that I am not a perfect person, and that I will need the power of Christ's death and resurrection to overcome my sins, part of which means relying on the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation and Confession to grow in grace.
- _____ I would like to accept Christ's mission in the world as my own and want the Holy Spirit to help me live that mission throughout my life as a disciple of the Lord Jesus.
- _____ I am genuinely open to helping others encounter Jesus and His love.
- _____ I hope to deepen my faith so that I may bring others to baptism so they in turn will know the saving power of Jesus Christ through his death and Resurrection.
- _____ I want to make it a priority in my life to help those in need, especially in the ways that Jesus asked of His disciples (mercy, kindness, compassion, forgiveness)
- _____ I want to strive to perform the Corporal Works of Mercy (feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, comfort the sick...) as Jesus commanded. (Mt: 25)
- _____ I intend to continue in my faith formation and to be involved in some kind of ministry in my faith community after Confirmation.
- _____ I intend to continue to be a part of parish faith formation after being Confirmed.
