letter to the Colossians. This letter
responds to a widespread belief
that God ruled the world through
the mediation of angels who were
given their own powers. The author
quotes an early Christian hymn that
emphasizes that Jesus is the one
and only mediator between God and
the world.

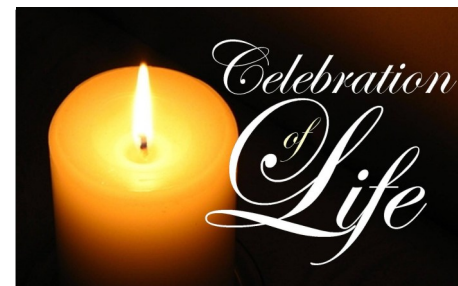
