



INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Cycle C)

First Reading: Genesis 14:18-20

Today's reading from the book of Genesis tells us all we know about an obscure king named Melchizedek. Abraham had just won a military victory, and Melchizedek honors him with a meal of bread and wine. Over the course of time, this meal was seen as a distant foreshadowing of the Eucharist, which is why this passage was chosen for today's feast.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 The first letter to the Corinthians was written about 25 years after Christ's death and resurrection. Today's passage contains our earliest written account of what Jesus did at the Last Supper. It predates even the Gospels.

The nearby Saint Joseph Mission Church at Harts' Sleeping Place, Carrolltown, will also be open from Noon - 3:00 PM on June 29th.



Stewardship Reflection



Story Time for children 2-5 years old This Tuesday, June 24th at 10:00 AM. in the St. Mary Convent Building Library.


