INTRODUCTION FOR TODAY'S READINGS
**Solemnity of the Most Holy Body
and Blood of Christ (Cycle C)**

First Reading: Genesis 14:18-20
Today's reading from the book of Genesis tells us all
we know about an obscure king named Melchizedek.
Abraham had just won a military victory, and Melchizedek
honors him with a meal of bread and wine. Over the
course of time, this meal was seen as a distant
foreshadowing of the Eucharist, which is why this
passage was chosen for today's feast.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26
The first letter to the Corinthians was written about 25
years after Christ's death and resurrection. Today's
passage contains our earliest written account of what
Jesus did at the Last Supper. It predates even the
Gospels.

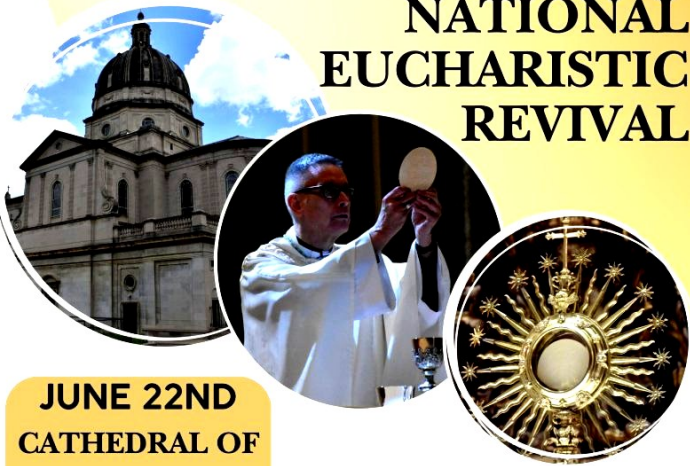

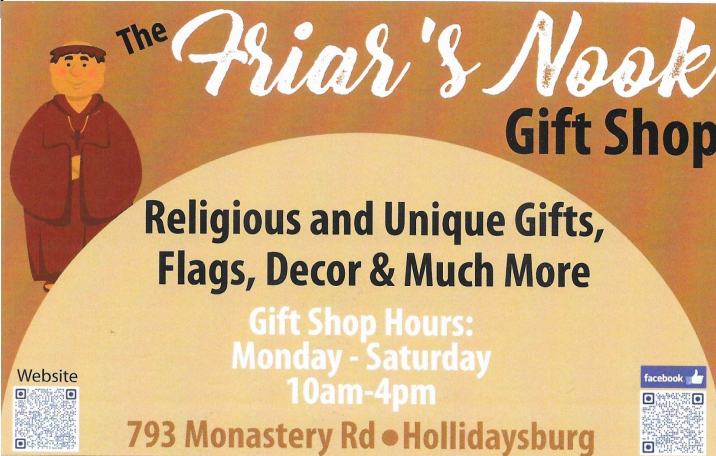

Stewardship Reflection

This week we observed the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. This beautiful feast celebrates the gift of the Eucharist, which the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* teaches is the source and summit of our Christian faith. "For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ Himself" (CCC 1324).

The very word, Eucharist, means "thanksgiving" or "gratitude" and so this feast is especially meaningful to all of us who are striving to live as grateful stewards of all God's blessings to us. Surely the Eucharist is the greatest of all blessings because it is not only from God, it is God – the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord, Jesus Christ.
