INTRODUCTION FOR **TODAY'S READINGS**

The Exaltation of the **Holy Cross**

First Reading: Numbers 21:4-9 The book of Numbers continues the story of the Israelites' journey from Egypt to the Promised Land. Today's passage tells of a time when the people were complaining during their journey. The incident described is one that we will hear Jesus use in the Gospel to describe the saving effects of his being lifted up

on the cross.

Second Reading: Philippians 2:6-11 In the years following Christ's death and resurrection, Christians began to develop the prayers and hymns that would become part of their rituals. In today's passage from the letter to the Philippians, Paul appears to be quoting an early Christian hymn celebrating the dying and rising of Christ.







DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE BUS TRIP TO WASHINGTON, DC

An ordinary Jubilee Year is celebrated only every 25 years. Making a pilgrimage to obtain a plenary Indulgence to either enter through a Holy Door designated by the Pope or visiting a Holy Site named by a local bishop is a very important foundation of the Jubilee tradition. For some this may be your last Jubilee! The Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception was named as an official Holy Site by the United States Catholic Conference of Bishops in November, 2024. This is a great opportunity to visit a Holy Site during this Jubilee Year.

The Diocese of Altoona-Johnstown has contracted 14 buses for the local Jubilee Pilgrimage. The trip to The Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, DC is Friday, October 17, 2025.
