

Autobiography

Nurkusheva Lyazzat Tuleuvna, born in 1955. Born in a family:

Father Tuleu Nurkushevich Nurkushev born in 1914 - the origin of the famous Kazakh clan "Tore", he managed to restore the entire branch of the family tree, which begins with Dzhuchikhan, the eldest of the seven sons of Genghis Khan.


Mother: Dzhaksylykova Sandygul Dzhaksylykovna, born in 1924 Dad was a miner by profession, worked and built Turksib, a front-line soldier was drafted in the early years of World War II, fought on the territory of the Second Belarusian Front. After being seriously wounded, he was commissioned in 1943. The train with wounded fighters for a long time was on the territory of the station "Lugovoy" near the city of Taraz. The wounded soldiers were cared for by a young girl with the beautiful name Sandygul, who subsequently reciprocated the soldier's flare-up of sympathy. Mom was 15 years younger than dad.

In 1982, she entered the target graduate school from the AASI (Almaty Institute of Architecture and Civil Engineering) in absentia to the Moscow Institute of TsNIIEP Educational Buildings from correspondence education and was transferred to full-time education in Moscow. After graduating from graduate school, she worked as a senior researcher in the NIS AASI sector as an executor of four research topics that were assigned to the departments "Building structures" and "Architecture of residential and public buildings", the customers of which were TsNIIEP of educational buildings.

Since 1986, he has been working at KazGASA at the Department of Fundamentals of Architectural Design, and since 1991, he has been working at the Department of Design. From December 2004 to the end of the academic year 2004-2005 she worked as the head of the specialized department "Design of the architectural environment". She was a member of the team of authors of RUE developers specializing in DAS, is the developer of a number of educational work programs.

After the structural reorganization in KazGASA, she worked as an associate professor of FD since September 2005. From April 2006 to September she worked as the Dean of the Faculty of Design.

Since 2006, she has headed a new direction in the specialty "Design" - the specialization "Industrial Design". Currently I work as an academic professor at the FD. I have prepared an educational and methodological complex of twenty-three disciplines (EMCD). Currently, I teach at the senior courses such disciplines as: "Integrated Design", "Design of Collectible Products", "History of Technology and Industrial Design", "Typology of Industrial Design", "Ergonomics", "Design Methods", "Typology of the Architectural Environment", "Detailed Design", "Undergraduate Design", "Elements and Processes of Industrial Design", "Design of Industrial Design Objects", etc. She trained nine masters who are currently successfully working in their specialization.





I have more than one hundred and twenty publications, including ten guidelines and manuals and three monographs.

She defended her dissertation for the degree of candidate of architecture in the specialty 18.00.01. Theory and history of architecture, restoration and reconstruction of historical and architectural heritage, on the topic "Development of the architectural and planning structure of educational and scientific complexes" (on the example of universities in Kazakhstan).

In 2010, in December, she defended her doctoral thesis: "Ways to transform the structure of an educational institution in modern conditions" for the degree of Doctor of Architecture. On February 27, 2012, by protocol No. 1 of the Higher Attestation Commission of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Nurkusheva L.T. approved the dissertation work. and awarded the qualification of Doctor of Architecture,

As the head of creative and research work, she prepared a large number of students for Republican and international competitions, which at various times became laureates of the Republican and International levels.

In 2013, she became the owner of the Honorary Title "The Best Teacher of the Year", the certificate and medal were presented by the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan.



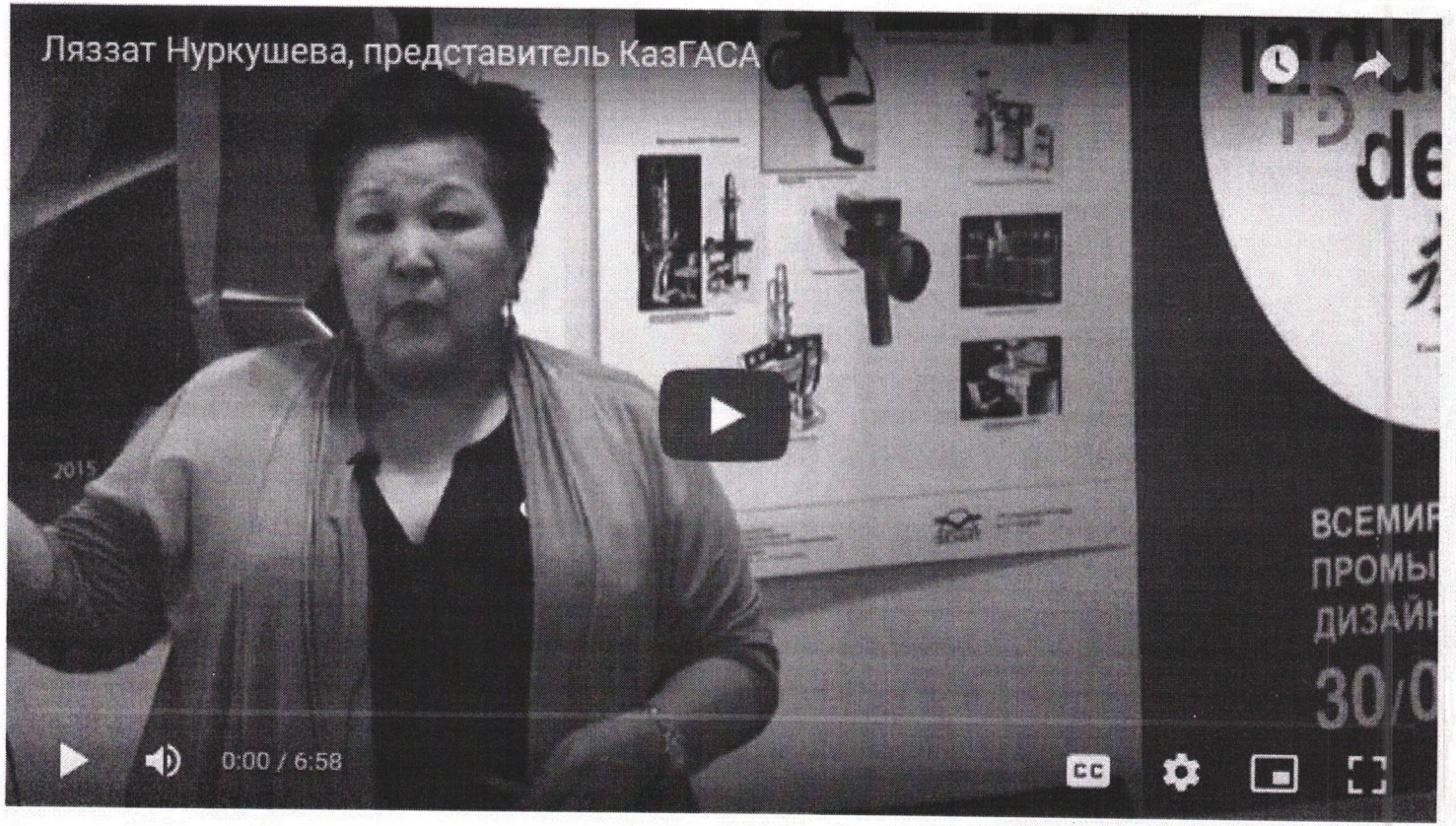

Description

The badge of the order is made of silver and is a gilded five-pointed star, the rays of which are covered with green enamel and end with elements of the Kazakh ornament. Between the beams there are silver shtrals in the form of diverging beams. In the center of the badge there is a round medallion of blue enamel with the image of a golden sun. Under the medallion there is a red enamel ribbon with the inscription "**Kurmet**" .

With the help of a link in the form of an element of the Kazakh ornament, the badge is suspended from a hexagonal order block, covered with an order ribbon.
