MALE KILLED AFTER BEING SHOT IN OSHAWA

A 29-year-old male is the 11th homicide victim of 2024 in Durham Region.

On Tuesday, December 31, 2024, at approximately 2:00 p.m., members of East Division responded to reports of an armed person at 1040 Cedar Street in Oshawa. Officers arrived on scene and located a male shot inside the building, he was pronounced deceased on scene.

The victim has been identified as 29-year-old Dennis Binda of Oshawa.

MALE WANTED FOR ROBBERY A RESTAURANT IN PICKERING

Police are looking for a man who robbed a restaurant in Pickering with a knife.

On Wednesday, December 25, 2024, at approximately 8:30 p.m., members from West Division responded to a robbery at Hellman Kabob, located at 2200 Brock Road. The suspect threatened an employee with a knife and demanded money. The employee handed over a quantity of cash, and the suspect fled the scene. No physical injuries were reported.

The suspect is described as: male, brown, 40-50 years old, wearing black sunglasses, a dark face covering, black hat, black jacket, black hoodie, black pants and black shoes.

MALE ARRESTED AFTER BREAK-AND-ENTER AT OSHAWA CANADIAN TIRE

A male is facing charges after breaking into a Canadian Tire in Oshawa.

On Tuesday, December 24, 2024, at approximately 5:10 a.m., members of Central East Division responded to a break-and-enter in progress at the Canadian Tire automotive store, located at 1333 Wilson Road North. A male suspect broke into the business and attempted to steal merchandise. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect who fled the area on foot. Officers engaged in a short foot pursuit before taking the

suspect into custody.

The suspect was linked to a previous break-and-enter at the same location.

Tyler Leo LAZURE, age 40 from Oshawa is charged with: Break-and-Enter x2, and Fail to Comply with Probation Order x2.

MALE ARRESTED FOLLOWING HUMAN TRAFFICKING INVESTIGATION

A male is facing charges after the completion of a human trafficking investigation.

On Monday, December 30, 2024, members of the Human Trafficking Unit (HTU), attended the area of York Street and Bremner Boulevard, in Toronto, in relation to an ongoing investigation. A male believed to be trafficking a 15-year-old female from Durham Region, was located and taken into custody without incident. Subsequently, a search warrant was conducted on the suspect's residence leading to the seizure of drugs and cash.

Shaun FAIRFAX, age 25 of No Fixed Address is charged with: Trafficking in Person Under 18, Material Benefit from Trafficking in Persons Under 18, Material Benefit from Sexual Services Under 18, Advertise Another Person Sexual Services, House Holder Permitting Prohibited Sexual Activity, and Procuring Under 18.

TWO ARRESTED AFTER BREAK-AND-ENTER IN WHITBY

Two males are in custody after breaking into a residence in Whitby.

On Tuesday, December 24, 2024, at approximately 5:55 a.m., members of Central West Division responded to a break-and-enter at a residence in the area of Princess Street and Cassels Road East. Two males used a stolen garage door remote to access the garage of a residence. Officers arrived on scene and took one male into custody without incident. The second male fled the area in a grey SUV.

Officers searched the area and later located the suspect vehicle. A traffic stop was ini-

tiated and the second suspect was taken into custody without incident.

POLICE SEEKING SUSPECTS IN BEAVERTON STABBING

Police are looking for a number of suspects after a stabbing in Beaverton.

On Wednesday, January 1, 2025, at approximately 4:50 a.m., members of North Division responded to the area of Park Avenue and Osborne Street for a stabbing. Officers arrived on scene and located an adult male victim suffering from stab wounds. The victim was approached by the suspects near Mill Street and Bay Street. After a brief interaction, the victim was stabbed.

The victim was transported to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

SUSPECTS SOUGHT AFTER ARMED BREAK-AND-ENTER IN AJAX

Several suspects are being sought after an armed break-and-enter at a residence in Ajax.

On Thursday, December 19, 2024, at approximately 8:50 p.m., members of West Division responded to an armed break-and-enter at a residence in the area of Rossland Road East and Lloydminster Avenue. Witnesses reported that sev-

eral males armed with handguns broke into a residence and we're seen leaving with numerous valuables. The suspects fled the area in a white SUV and black sedan, prior to police arrival. The residence was unoccupied at the time of the break-and-enter, and no physical injuries have been reported to police.

SHOTS FIRED INTO WHITBY RESIDENCE

A suspect is being sought after shots were fired into a residence in Whitby.

On Sunday December 22, 2024, at approximately 10:35 p.m., members of Central West Division responded for gun shots reported in the area of Rivers Edge Place and Taunton Road East. A male wearing dark clothing was seen fleeing the area in a white Mercedes SUV. Officers arrived on scene and located a residence with several bullet holes. The residence was unoccupied at the time of the shooting, and no injuries have been reported to police.

LATE NIGHT SHOTS FIRED IN AJAX

Police are appealing for witnesses after a late-night shooting on Thursday in Ajax. On Thursday, December 19, 2024, at approximately 11:30 p.m., members of West Division responded to the area of Wilsongary Circle and Gavin Lane for reports of gunshots.

Officers arrived on scene and located multiple shell casings in the area. One residence has been located with bullet holes.

MALE ARMED WITH SHOTGUN ARRESTED AFTER MAKING THREATS IN OSHAWA

A male is in custody after he made threats with a shotgun outside a residence in Oshawa.

On Tuesday, December 17, 2024, at approximately 12:50

p.m., members of Central West Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Thornton Road North and Winchester Road West. A male made threats with a shotgun toward three other males who attended the property to enforce an eviction. The three victims exited the property and contacted police. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect barricaded inside of his residence. Police set up containment and closed the roadways as they negotiated with the male. After lengthy negotiations, the suspect safely surrendered himself to police and was taken into custody without incident. A shotgun, rifle, and ammunition were seized following a search of the residence.

The victims did not sustain any physical injuries.

Steven Rejean COTE, age 64 of Whitby is charged with: Possess Firearm - No licence x9, Careless Use of a Firearm x2, Possession of a Firearm with Ammunition x2, Possession of a Prohibited Device x2, Utter Threats, and Assault with a Weapon.

FOUR IN CUSTODY AFTER ASSAULT IN OSHAWA

Three males and one female are facing charges after a violent assault at a residence in Oshawa.

On Sunday, December 15, 2024, at approximately 5:10 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to an unknown trouble call at a residence in the area of Graburn Avenue and Drew Street. Police were called after three males were seen dragging another male into a residence. Officers arrived on

scene and saw several parties fleeing the residence. One suspect was taken into custody without incident, while two other suspects remain outstanding. A search of the residence located two additional males and a female, who were taken into custody without incident. A firearm was also located inside the residence.

The victim was transported to a local area hospital with serious but non-life-threatening injuries.

Nathan Daniel KELLY, age 36 from Oshawa is charged with: Aggravated Assault, Possess Loaded Restricted/Prohibited Firearm, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Firearm - No Licence, Possession of a Prohibited Device, and Possession Contrary to Order.

Mackenzey Lee SIGOUIN, age 28 from Oshawa is charged with: Possess Loaded Restricted/Prohibited Firearm, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Firearm - No Licence, and Possession of a Prohibited Device.

Kevin BOUTILIER, age 45 from Niagara Falls is charged with: Possess Loaded Restricted/Prohibited Firearm, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Firearm - No Licence, Possession of a Prohibited Device, Possession Contrary to Order x2, and Fail to Comply with Probation Order x3.

Daniel CARRIGAN, age 62 from Niagara Falls is charged with: Possess Loaded Restricted/Prohibited Firearm, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Firearm - No Licence, and Possession of a Prohibited Device.
