### Male Stabbed over Theft of Meat in Oshawa

Investigators are trying to identify several suspects after a male was robbed and stabbed over a backpack of meat in Oshawa. On Sunday, June 9, 2019 at approximately 10:55 a.m., members of Central East Division responded to the area of Ontario Street in Oshawa. The victim, a 30-year-old Oshawa male, was attempting to sell some meat which he had in his backpack, when three suspects assaulted him, stabbed him numerous times in the leg and fled with the backpack full of meat. Police searched the area with negative results. The victim suffered serious but non-life threatening injuries and was taken to local hospital. The victim was not forthcoming with information, witnesses described the suspects as being both male.

### Male Stabbed in Oshawa Park

Investigators are trying to identify a female suspect after a male received multiple, minor stab wounds during an altercation at an Oshawa park. On Sunday, June 9, 2019 at approximately 12:30 a.m., Central East Division Officers, already in Lakeridge Health – Oshawa on an unrelated manner, witnessed a male enter the emergency department with multiple, minor wounds. He was treated for several minor injuries and later released. The 25-year-old male said he had been in Memorial Park several hours earlier and was drinking with strangers, including two unknown females, when a fight broke out. The male said he was stabbed several times by one of the females. Believing the wounds to be minor, the male went to his girlfriend's house in Oshawa and she later convinced him to go to hospital for treatment. The female suspect is described as white, about 5'5" tall, wearing red sneakers, red pants and a red jacket.

### Anti-Semitic Graffiti Found In Whitby

Police are investigating after several hand-written signs containing anti-Semitic language and symbols were located in a Whitby neighbourhood. On Sunday June 9, 2019, just before 8:00 a.m. a resident contacted police after locating three pieces of scrap wood with writing on them in Peel Park on Trent Street. Similar signs were later located nearby in the neighbourhood of Burns Street and Athol Street.

### Robbery Suspect Detained by Citizens

A robbery suspect was detained by citizens after attempting to rob an Oshawa store. On Friday, June 7, 2019 at approximately 8:40 p.m., members of Central East Division were called to Ray's Smoke Shop on Simcoe Street South near Ritson Road South in Oshawa regarding an armed robbery. A lone male, with his face covered, entered the store and

pointed a firearm at the employee, demanding money. The employee recognized the gun to be fake, attempted to grab the gun and fought with the accused. At one point, the suspect ran from the store followed by the employee. Two males detained the fleeing suspect, who sustained minor injuries while attempting to escape. Officers arrived and took the male into custody and recovered a replica handgun. The accused was transported to a local hospital to be assessed for minor injuries.

**Ron WILLIAMS**, age 45, of Ritson Road South in Oshawa has been charged with: Robbery with a Firearm; Wear Disguise; Weapons Dangerous; Fail to Comply with Probation Order; and Breach of Recognizance.

### Elderly Female Pedestrian Sustains Serious Injuries

A 78-year-old female from Oshawa was seriously injured after she was struck by a Durham Region Transit bus in Oshawa Saturday afternoon. On Saturday, June 8, 2019, at approximately 1:30 p.m., members from East Division were called to serious pedestrian-involved collision at the intersection of Harmony Road and Olive Avenue in Oshawa. The elderly female was walking her small dog and waiting at the southeast corner to cross northbound at the intersection. The involved transit bus was southbound on Harmony Road and was making a left turn to proceed eastbound on Olive Avenue. The bus came in contact with the pedestrian within the intersection. The elderly female sustained serious but non-life threatening injuries. She was taken to a local hospital. The driver of the bus remained at the scene and co-operated with investigators.

### Fatal Single Motor Vehicle Collision

A 55-year-old Pickering male was killed after being run over by a commercial car transport in Pickering. On Sunday, June 9, 2019 at approximately 11:16 p.m., members of West Division were called to motor vehicle collision in which an individual was run over and dragged by a vehicle on Alliance Road in Pickering. A large Peterbilt commercial car transport was stopped in a private lot, when the driver, a 55-year old Pickering male, exited the vehicle and was in the process of attempting repairs underneath the vehicle. Later, one of the owners of the truck company entered the vehicle and attempted to move it, unknowingly causing the driver underneath to be dragged. The male was severely injured and sustained fatal injuries as a result. The 22-year old Markham male who attempted to move the vehicle remained on scene and rendered assistance.

### Robbery Suspect Sought after Convenience Store Robbery in Oshawa

Robbery investigators arrested a suspect from a convenience store robbery in early May. On May 31, 2019 investigators arrested a robbery suspect who allegedly robbed the Marland Convenience store on May 7, 2019 at knife-point.

**Nathan TOUGH**, age 26 of Marland Avenue in Oshawa is charged with Robbery; Disguise with Intent; Possession of Weapon Dangerous to Public and Fail to Comply x2.

### Suspect Arrested with Firearm in Oshawa Bar

A 38-year-old male faces firearms-related charges after his arrest at an Oshawa bar Monday night. On Monday, June 3, 2019, at approximately 6:00 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a threatening call at Crazy Jacks Bar & Grill on King Street West in Oshawa. The suspect is alleged to have made threats towards others and was possibly armed with a knife. Officers located the male on the patio and the male was taken into custody without incident. Officers seized three knives and located a firearm in the suspect's backpack.

**Jerry BRUNETTE**, age 38 of No Fixed Address is charged with: Possession of a Weapon Dangerous to the Public; Careless Carry of Firearm; Contravene Storage Regulation; Carry Concealed Weapon; Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm; Possession of a Firearm Knowing it's Possession is Unauthorized; Theft Under \$5,000; Breach of Peace Bond and Possession of Firearm Obtained by Crime.

### Motorcyclist Arrested for Assaulting Police Officer

A 33-year-old motorist from Toronto was arrested after he fled from police and then assaulted an officer. On Sunday, June 2, 2019, at approximately 6:53 p.m., an officer from West Division observed a motorcycle being operated without a license plate in the area of Kingston Road and Glenanna Road in Pickering. The officer attempted to conduct a traffic stop, but the motorcycle sped away at a high rate of speed. The driver was seen dangerously weaving in and out of lanes. Due to safety concerns, the officer did not pursue the motorcycle. However, a short time later he saw the motorcycle stopped at a red light at Kingston Road and Rougemount Drive. The officer blocked the motorcycle in the intersection and the motorcyclist aggressively spun his wheels and eventually made contact with the cruiser. The driver was ejected from the motorcycle and then attempted to flee on foot. The officer was able to catch up to the driver and, with the help of two citizens who came to assist, was able to subdue the driver and place him under arrest.

### Suspects Wanted for Knife-Point Robbery in Oshawa

Police are looking for two suspects after a convenience store was robbed in Oshawa Tuesday night. On Tuesday, May 28, 2019, at approximately 12:30 a.m., members of Central East Division were dispatched to a robbery call at the Circle K convenience store on Wentworth Street in Oshawa. Police arrived and the clerk indicated a lone male armed with a knife entered the store and made a demand for cash. Another male stood by the door and held it open. The male grabbed cigarettes and cash before fleeing on foot. Police searched the area with negative results. The clerk was not physically harmed during the incident. Suspect #1 is described as: male, white, 20s, dark beard, dark hair. He was wearing a hooded sweater, black pants, black shoes and had a backpack. He was armed with a

knife. There is no suspect description for the second male.

### Suspect Wanted in Sexual Assault Investigation

A male suspect is wanted after a teenaged girl was touched inappropriately in Oshawa. On Monday, May 27, 2019, at approximately 11:50 a.m., the teenaged female victim was walking on a bike path near Riverside Drive in Oshawa when the victim was approached by an unknown male who was walking behind her. The male touched the teen inappropriately and when the female screamed for help, he ran away. The victim didn't suffer any physical injuries. Police responded and searched the area with negative results. Investigators are looking for a suspect described as: male, white, mid 30s, 6' tall, large muscular build, brown facial hair, mid-length brown hair and a tanned complexion. He was wearing a blue T-shirt with a logo on the front. The suspect was observed hitting his face and speaking to himself as he ran off.



### Two Suspects Wanted For Bank Account Fraud

Police are looking for two suspects after almost \$40,000 was taken from an Ajax woman's bank account. The 60-year-old woman reported she was contacted by her bank in March 2019 to advise there had been fraudulent activity on her account. Two suspects are seen on surveillance video accessing the woman's account, both in person and at bank machines. The fraudulent transactions took place between March 25-27, 2019. The suspects attended bank tellers and bank machines in Oshawa, Sunderland, Belleville and Lindsay.
