MALE IN CUSTODY AFTER SHOOTING IN PICKERING

A male has been arrested after he shot at a vehicle in Pickering.

On Monday, September 9, 2024, at approximately 6:35 a.m., members of West Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Sapphire Drive and Dragonfly Avenue. A male shot at a parked vehicle before fleeing the area on foot. Police searched the area and located the suspect, who fled from officers. During the foot pursuit, the suspect discarded a handgun into a green space, before being taken into custody. The handgun was located and seized. No physical injuries were sustained by any parties as a result of the shooting.

This was an isolated incident. **Liam Jacob MILLER-NORTH**, age 25 from Pickering is charged with numerous offences including: Prowl at Night, Point Firearm, Possess Firearm No Licence, Possess Loaded Firearm, Discharge Firearm, and Mischief Over \$5000.

SUSPECT ARRESTED FOR ARSON IN OSHAWA

Police have arrested one male and are searching for another male after an arson in Oshawa. On Sunday, December 3, 2023, members of East Division responded to a fire call in the area of Jim Brewster Circle and Fleetwood Drive. Two males were seen fleeing the area in a dark coloured BMW sedan after a home was lit on fire. Investigators, along with the Ontario Fire Marshal, determined that the fire was the result of arson. The BMW was later confirmed to be a stolen vehicle. On Sunday, September 9, 2024, the first suspect was taken into custody. The second suspect is still outstanding.

Taha ALI, age 20 from Scarborough is charged with: Arson Causing Property Damage x2, Possess Incendiary Material for Arson, Arson – Disregard for Human Life x2, Endanger

Lives/Safety of Public, Possess property Obtained by Crime Exceeding \$5000, and Conspiracy to Commit and Indictable Offence.

TWO ARRESTED FOR DRUG POSSESSION AFTER TRAFFIC STOP IN CLARINGTON

Two males are facing charges for drug possession following a traffic stop in Clarington. On Friday, September 6, 2024, at approximately 8:15 p.m., members of the East Division Community Response Team (CRT) initiated a traffic stop while on proactive patrol in the area of Highway 115 and Concession Road 4. Officers observed a Ford SUV driving at a high rate of speed, and attempted a traffic stop. The SUV failed to stop and continued driving at a high rate of speed. Officers pulled alongside the SUV to identify the driver, who then slowly brought the vehicle to a stop. The driver presented a licence to police that was not his. A subsequent search of the vehicle, under the Cannabis Control Act, revealed a quantity of drugs. The driver and passenger were taken into custody without incident.

Eden MIGISHA, age 23 from Toronto is charged with numerous offences including: Possess Schedule 1 Substance for the Purposes of Trafficking (cocaine), Obstruct Justice, Posses Identity Document of Another, and Drive Motor Vehicle While Suspended x2.

Bruce ARAKAZA, age 26 from Toronto is charged with: Possess Schedule 1 Substance for the Purposes of Trafficking (cocaine).

TWO FACING CHARGES FOR MULTIPLE STOLEN VEHICLES IN UXBRIDGE

A male and female are facing charges after multiple stolen vehicles were located near their residence in Uxbridge.

On Monday, March 4, 2024, members of North Division responded to a stolen vehicle call in the area of Brewster Road and Concession Road 5. Two stolen SUVs were

located unoccupied and seized.

On Tuesday, April 16, 2024, members of North Division responded to a suspicious vehicle call at a property in the area of Brewster Road and Concession Road 5. Investigators received information that multiple newer vehicles were parked in an agricultural area on the property. Officers were given permission from the property owner to check the area, and located four stolen vehicles. A search warrant was sought for neighbouring fields leading to three more stolen vehicles, of which two had been re-venned.

On Friday, August 30, 2024, members of Project Attire, with the assistance of the North Division Community Response Team, concluded their investigation into the stolen vehicles and arrested a male and female who had been renting a home on the property.

A FEMALE HAS SERIOUS INJURIES AFTER A MOTORCYCLE COLLISION IN WHITBY

A 16-year-old female was seriously injured after a collision in Whitby.

On Saturday September 7, 2024, at approximately 7:07 p.m., members from Central West Division were called to a collision involving a motorcycle and a passenger van on

Dundas Street at the south-bound Hwy 412 Exit Ramp.

A Kia Sedona Van being operated by a 46-year-old male from Whitby was exiting highway 412 at Dundas Street West with the intention of turning eastbound on Dundas Street West. Traffic in the area was heavy and the Kia was attempting to cross two westbound lanes of traffic. As the Kia's operator began his turn, a Yamaha motorcycle operated by a 16-year-old female from Whitby was west-bound in the centre lane. As the Kia crossed the centre westbound lane the motorcycle collided with the driver's door of the van.

As a result, the 16-year-old motorcycle operator was seriously injured. She was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre where she remains with serious injuries.

18-YEAR-OLD MALE SUFFERS SERIOUS INJURIES AFTER A COLLISION IN OSHAWA

Investigators have laid charges against a driver in a collision that left two people with serious injuries in June.

On Friday, June 21st, 2024, at approximately 3:45 p.m., members from Central East Division responded to a report of a collision involving four motor vehicles on Ritson Road just north of Wildflower Court, in Oshawa. A green GMC pickup truck was heading southbound when it lost control and hit a black Buick Vera, also going southbound, followed by two northbound vehicles, a grey Toyota RAV4 and a grey Jeep. The green GMC pickup truck rolled onto its side causing significant damage to the two north-bound vehicles.

The driver of the Green GMC pickup is now facing charges. **Graeme DAY**, age 18 of Oshawa is charged with Dangerous Operation Cause

Bodily Harm x2. FEMALE FACING CHARGES AFTER THREAT MADE AGAINST DURHAM COLLEGE

An 18-year-old female from Whitby has been charged after making a threat over Snapchat.

On Thursday, September 5, 2024 the Durham Regional Police Service received information from the RCMP that a concerning snapchat message had been intercepted. The message indicated a female's desire to initiate a shooting at a school in Oshawa. Investigators were able to trace the message back to an 18-year-old Durham College student. Members from Central West division attended the Durham College campus located at 2000 Simcoe Street North, where the suspect was arrested without incident.

Following her arrest, a Criminal Code search warrant was executed at her home address in Whitby. During the search warrant, 18 firearms, five air soft guns more than 1,000 rounds of ammunition were seized. The firearms were acquired and stored lawfully.

Jhusmin PAGKALIWAGAN, age 18 from Whitby has been charged with Uttering Threats.

A FEMALE IS IN CRITICAL CONDITION AFTER BEING STRUCK BY VEHICLE IN WHITBY

On Saturday, September 7, 2024 at approximately 6:20 a.m., members from Central West Division responded to a female being struck by a vehicle at Consumer Drive just east of Paisley Court in Whitby. A 23-year-old female had just exited a bus and was crossing the street when she was struck by a vehicle, which is believed to have run a red light. The vehicle that struck the female fled the scene and was last seen westbound on Victoria Street West from Brock Street South.

The female pedestrian was transported to a Toronto-area trauma hospital with life-threatening injuries.

Investigators are looking for a 2010 four-door silver Jaguar XF. The vehicle may have damage to the front passenger side corner.

FEMALE DIES FOLLOWING MULTI-VEHICLE COLLISION IN OSHAWA

A 40-year-old male is now facing charges following a collision that killed a 41-year-old female from Oshawa.

On Saturday, August 10, 2024, at approximately 12:15 p.m., members from Central East Division were called to a multi-vehicle collision on Ritson Road South near Bloor Street. Information was received that a black Mercedes sedan being operated by a 40-year-old male from Toronto was travelling southbound on Ritson Road South at a high rate of speed. As the Mercedes entered the curb lane it struck a white Nissan being operated by a 41-year-old female from Oshawa. The force of the initial impact caused the driver of the Nissan to lose control, striking a Chevy Orlando, which then caught on fire. The white Nissan then struck a Honda and Dodge Caravan, which also caught fire. Multiple other vehicles were also struck by the Honda and Chevrolet Orlando.

The Mercedes continued southbound after the initial collision, crossing the north-bound lanes and careening onto the property on the northeast corner. As it crossed the property it struck the rear corner of a chip-truck causing the awning to collapse on a male party that was awaiting food. The Mercedes then crashed into a light pole.

The 41-year-old female in the Nissan was pronounced deceased at the scene and nine other parties were taken to a local area hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.
