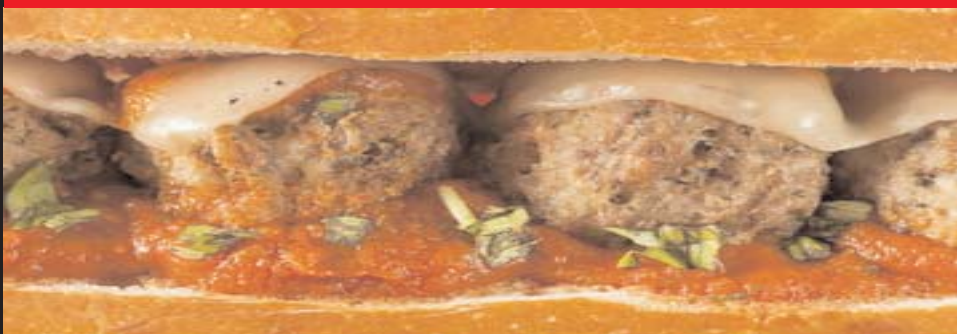

HOME INVASION IN OSHAWA

Investigators are looking for a lone suspect who entered a home, stabbed and assaulted a male in his bedroom. On Wednesday, September 23, 2020, at approximately 10:30 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a home on Buena Vista Avenue in Oshawa after a male had been stabbed and beaten. The suspect entered the home and made his way to the victim's bedroom and stabbed him and assaulted him. The suspect then fled on foot. The victim was taken to a local hospital with serious but non-life threatening injuries. Police searched the area with negative results. The suspect is described as male, black with a thin build. This was not a random attack.

TRAFFIC STOP LEADS TO GUN SEIZURE

A traffic stop led to a firearm being taken off the streets. On Tuesday, September 22, 2020, at approximately 11:30 p.m., members of Central West Division were on patrol when they stopped the driver of a four-door Acura suspected of being impaired in the area of Winchester Road and Watford Street in Whitby. The

traffic stop revealed open bottles of alcohol in the vehicle and a search of the vehicle resulted in a handgun being found inside. The driver and two occupants were arrested and charged and the driver passed a roadside breath test.

Pratheep PARAMANANTHAN, age 29 of Blackwell Avenue in Toronto, and **Sajeeth SELVANATHAN**, age 27, of Boulderbrook Drive in Toronto are charged with: Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm in a Car; Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm Knowing it is Unauthorized; Unauthorized Possession of a Prohibited Firearm and Careless Storage of a Firearm.

Gajan APPADURAI, age 39 of Rosedrop Path in Oshawa, who was the driver, is charged with: Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm in a Car; Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm Knowing it is Unauthorized; Unauthorized Possession of a Prohibited Firearm; Careless Storage of a Firearm; Fail to Comply with Recognizance and Drive Motor Vehicle with Liquor Readily Available.

STREET-LEVEL ROBBERY IN AJAX

Investigators are asking the public to help identify a suspect in an armed street-level robbery which occurred in Ajax.

On Friday, September 18, 2020, at approximately 9:15 a.m., members of West Division were called to the area of Clements Road in Ajax for a street level robbery. The victim was walking west-bound when he was approached by an unknown male who was armed with a knife. The suspect made a demand for his property. The suspect took a cell-phone and fled on foot.

It's believed that the suspect is associated to a dark Mazda sedan. The victim didn't receive any physical injuries. Officers searched the area, with negative results. The suspect is described as male, white, 6' tall, dark brown hair in his 20's. He had black pants, black shoes, a blue t-shirt with "Bench" in white lettering across the front. He was armed with a knife.

FOUR CHARGED IN VEHICLE FRAUD INVESTIGATION

Two Oshawa men were arrested and charged in connection with the fraudulent

purchase of a luxury vehicle. An investigation into one of the Oshawa men connected him to a small group of people involved in a vehicle acquisition fraud. The men made arrangements for a 26-year-old Toronto woman to purchase a 2016 Mercedes Benz E400 in Mississauga, using fraudulent identification they provided to her. The female and the three men were identified and arrested in August and September 2020. The value of the vehicle (which was recovered), cash and property seized as part of this investigation is approximately \$120,000.

Malika WISDOM, age 26, of Victoria Park Avenue in Toronto is charged with: Fraud Over \$5,000; Possess Identification of Another Person; Possession of Property Obtained By Crime; Personation to Gain Advantage; and Make False Statement to Procure Loan.

Abeeku ARHIN, age 26, of Langley Circle in Oshawa has been charged with: Fraud Over \$5,000; Conspiracy to Commit an Indictable Offence; and Traffic Identification of Another Person.

Kenneth NKRUMAH, age 29, of Park Lawn Road in Toronto is charged with: Fraud Over \$5,000; Conspiracy to Commit an Indictable Offence; Traffic Identification of Another Person; Possession of Property Obtained by Crime; Possess Identity Documents of Another x3; Theft of Credit Card; and Possess Counterfeit Mark x3; **Leo ROBINSON**, age 30, of Aldershot Drive in Oshawa is charged with: Fraud Over \$5,000; and Conspiracy to Commit an Indictable Offence.

SUSPECT ARRESTED BY K-9 AFTER FLEEING FROM POLICE

A male suspect was apprehended by the K-9 Unit after he fled from police on Sunday night in Oshawa.

On Sunday, September 21, 2020, at approximately 10:00 p.m., members of Central East Division were called to the area of Simcoe Street and Rosland Road for an armed person call. Officers received information that there was a male on foot armed with a gun in that area. Police quickly responded and a member of the K-9 Unit located the suspect. The suspect fled on foot but was quickly caught by Police Service Dog Six. The suspect suffered minor injuries from a dog bite and was taken to a local hospital for treatment. Police found a starter's pistol and approximately \$2,000 worth of cannabis.

Lucas DAYTON, age 18, of No Fixed Address, was charged with: Possession of Cannabis for the Purpose of Selling and Fail to Comply.

AIR-1 HELPS TO NAB FEELING SUSPECTS

A 45-minute pursuit of suspects driving a vehicle ended with the help of Air-1.

On Friday, September 18, 2020, at 11:30 p.m., an officer from Central East Division attempted to pull over a black pickup truck on Tennyson Avenue in Oshawa. The vehicle did not pull over and a pursuit ensued. The vehicle was seen driving dangerously at high speeds. Due to safety concerns, the pursuit was called off on the ground. However, the DRPS helicopter, Air-1, kept an eye on the suspect vehicle from the skies.

The Air-1 team followed the vehicle for 45 minutes into

north Durham. Officers strategically placed a tire deflation device on Lakeridge Road North near Myrtle Road West and were able to stop the vehicle. Two men were placed under arrest. A search of the vehicle located brass knuckles and a Conducted Energy Weapon.

Jerry HOLROYD, age 39 of Elliott Street in Clarington, is charged with: Fail to Stop While Being Pursued; Dangerous Operation of a Conveyance; Operate Conveyance while Prohibited x8; Possess Weapons Dangerous x2; Possess Prohibited Weapon x2 and Fail to Comply with Probation Order x2.

Bradley POMEROY, age 29 of NFA, is charged with Possess Weapons Dangerous x2; Possess Prohibited Weapon x2; and Fail to Comply with Release Order.

SHOT FIRED IN AN APARTMENT COMPLEX IN AJAX

Police are investigating a gun being fired in an Ajax apartment building on Saturday morning.

On Saturday, September 19, 2020, at approximately 3:45 a.m., members of West Division were called to an apartment building on Kingston Road east of Chapman Road in Ajax for reports of a single gunshot that was heard. Officers responded to the area and found a casing in one of the stairwells of the building. There have been no reported injuries to any of the occupants of the apartment. Police searched the area with negative results. There are no suspect descriptors at this time.

MALE WITH A LOADED RIFLE ARRESTED

A 32-year-old Cannington male is facing firearm charges after he was seen with a loaded rifle on a residential driveway.

On Friday, September 11, 2020, at 9:11 p.m., officers from the Community Resource Unit in North Division were completing a compliance check at a residence on Maple Beach Road in Beaverton. While approaching the residence, the officers witnessed a male exit a vehicle parked in the driveway. He crouched down beside the open passenger door of the vehicle holding the rifle. Officers ordered the male to drop the firearm and he complied. The male was arrested without incident. **Ronald WRETHAM**, age 32 of Country Lane in Cannington, has been charged with five firearms charges including: Unauthorized Possession of a Firearm and Careless Storage of a Firearm.
