MALE SHOT IN PICKERING

Investigators have released surveillance images of a suspect and a suspect vehicle in relation to a shooting incident in Pickering on September 25, 2020.

The suspect is described as male, black, 5'9" tall, wearing a black hoodie, black shorts and a surgical mask. The vehicle he entered after the shooting is described as a silver or grey 2004/2005 Dodge Caliber. Victim is still recovering from his injuries.

FATHER STABBED BY SON IN AJAX

A suspect was arrested after one male was stabbed and another male wounded in a domestic-related incident Tuesday night in Ajax.

On Tuesday, January 12, 2021, at approximately 8:40 p.m., members of West Division responded to a residence in the area of Delaney Drive and Westney Road North in Ajax for a stabbing. Officers located a 57-year-old male victim with a life-threatening injury. He was taken to a Toronto-area trauma hospital where he remains in critical condition. A second 24-year-old male victim sustained a serious but non-life-threatening injury after being wounded and was taken to a local hospital. He has since been released.

The suspect, who is the 57-year-old victim's son and brother of the 24-year-old victim, was arrested and is facing numerous charges.

A 28-year-old male from Ajax is charged with Aggravated Assault; Assault Cause Bodily Harm; Assault with a Weapon; Assault and Possess Weapon for Committing an Offence.

SUSPECT ARRESTED IN HUMAN TRAFFICKING INVESTIGATION

A Whitby male was arrested Monday in Whitby in relation to a human trafficking investigation.

In December of 2020, the Human Trafficking Unit commenced an investigation after complaints from a 23-year-old female regarding human trafficking. The suspect, Nathan GREEN, procured the 23-year-old female to work for him as an escort in the sex trade.

Human Trafficking investigators arrested the suspect and he is facing numerous Human Trafficking charges.

Nathan GREEN, age 24, of Wood Drive in Whitby, was

arrested and charged with: Procuring/Exercise Control; Trafficking in Persons by Recruiting; Material Benefit Trafficking Persons Over 18; Material Benefit from Sexual Services; Advertising Sexual Services and Obtaining Sexual Services for Consideration.

STOLEN VEHICLE LOCATED AND TWO SUSPECTS ARRESTED

Officers arrested two suspects after officers stopped a stolen vehicle in Whitby overnight.

On Tuesday, January 12, 2021, at approximately 3:00 a.m., members of Central West Division responded for a possible impaired driver in the area of Stevenson Road South and Highway 401 in Oshawa. Officers attempted to stop the white Honda van, however the driver failed to stop for police. The suspect vehicle continued slowly on the westbound lanes of Highway 401. The suspect vehicle eventually came to a complete stop at Thickson Road ramp in Whitby. Police received information that the van was stolen from Clarington.

A female and male were arrested. Police also seized a small quantity of cocaine.

Chris PELLEY, age 30, of Mill Street in Oshawa is charged with: Flight from Police Officer; Fail to Comply with Order; Possess Cocaine for the Purpose of Trafficking and Possess Property Obtained by Crime.

Rochelle WATKIS, age 31 of Steele Valley Court in Whitby is charged with: Possess Property Obtained by Crime and Possess Cocaine for the Purpose of Trafficking.

SHOTS FIRED AT RESIDENCE AND VEHICLES IN AJAX

Police will be setting up a command post near Gamble Drive in Ajax to canvass the neighbourhood after two shootings that occurred within the last week.

On Wednesday, January 13, 2021, between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. investigators from the West Division Criminal Investigations Bureau will be canvassing the neighbourhood on Gamble Drive in Ajax. Over the past week there have been two shootings on this street. Community members are concerned for their safety and police would like to reassure them that this investigation is an isolated incident and they are utilizing all the available resources to identify the suspects responsible.

Investigators confirmed that they located the suspect vehicle in York Region after the January 7 incident engulfed in flames hours after the shooting. The suspects were picked up by a white newer model Mercedes with a sunroof.

Officers will be canvassing the neighbourhood and making efforts to locate any surveillance footage from nearby houses. Police are urging any witnesses to come speak with them at the command post (location to be determined).

SHOTS FIRED AT RESIDENCE AND VEHICLES

Police are investigating a second incident where multiple shots were fired at the same residence in Ajax. No injuries were reported.

On Sunday, January 10, 2021, at approximately 10:50 p.m., members of West Division were dispatched to a residence on Gamble Drive in the area of Salem Road and Taunton Road East in Ajax for shots fired. Officers arrived and discovered the residence had been struck by multiple bullets. One stray bullet struck a secondary residence. Multiple shell casings were located at the scene. There were no reported injuries.

A review of security footage from the area showed the gunshots came from inside a dark-coloured 4-door sedan vehicle.

AIR1 LOCATES MISSING CLARINGTON WOMAN

Air1 is being credited with saving the life of a Clarington woman, who was stuck in a marshy area after going for a walk.

In the early morning hours of Saturday, January 9, 2021, police were called about a missing, distraught 48-year-old Clarington woman, who was last seen at approximately 9 p.m. the night before. She had gone for a walk and did not take per purse, wallet or phone.

East Division officers immediately began searching the area of Highway 2 and Regional Road 57 in Bowmanville and police helicopter Air1 was brought in to assist with the ground search. The Public Safety Unit was

called in, as well.

At approximately 5 a.m., the missing female was located stuck in a swampy area near Martin Road and the Baseline Road West. Air1 directed ground units to the exact location and the female was removed from the swampy area and taken to hospital.

She was suffering from hypothermia and frost bite and was treated in the intensive care unit.

WARRANTS ISSUED FOR CRIMINAL HARASSMENT

Warrants have been issued for a 57-year-old male in a criminal harassment case in Durham Region.

Gerald BRUMMELL, age 57, of address unknown, is wanted in Durham Region for Criminal Harassment by Threatening Conduct x2 and Criminal Harassment by Repeated Communication x2. The accused is currently wanted on other warrants in Ontario for similar incidents. Investigators encourage the accused to contact a lawyer and turn himself in.

ARMED ROBBERY AT PIZZA STORE IN OSHAWA

Investigators are looking for a male suspect in an armed robbery of a pizza store in Oshawa Sunday morning.

On Sunday, January 10, 2021, at approximately 2:00 a.m., members of Central East Division were called to the Pizza Pizza store on King Street East in Oshawa for a commercial robbery. The suspect entered the store and ordered a slice before jumping over the counter armed with a large knife. The suspect made a demand for cash but was unsuccessful. The suspect smashed a window before fleeing on foot.

The victim didn't receive any physical injuries. Officers searched the area, with negative results.

The suspect is described as male, white, 5'7 to 6' tall, in his

20's. He had a blue jacket, hat and a black balaclava. He was armed with a large knife.

FATAL MOTOR VEHICLE COLLISION IN OSHAWA

A 56-year-old Oshawa male died as a result of a single motor vehicle collision in Oshawa on Sunday morning. On Sunday, January 10, 2021, at approximately 2:51 a.m., members of East Division were called to a serious motor vehicle collision involving a single motor vehicle. A 2013 white 4-door Honda Civic was travelling eastbound on King Street East of Harmony Road in Oshawa, when it left the roadway and struck a hydro pole on the north side of the road. The 56-year-old male driver, who was the lone occupant of the vehicle, was rushed to a local trauma center for medical treatment and was later pronounced deceased.

His name is being withheld at the discretion of his family. Members of the DRPS Collision Investigation Unit, attended the scene to conduct an investigation. The roads in the area were closed for several hours while evidence was collected. The cause of the collision remains under investigation.

MALE CHARGED WITH A HISTORIC SEXUAL ASSAULT

A 30-year-old Oshawa male has been charged with an historical sex assault on a teenager.

On Friday, January 8, 2021, investigators from the Sexual Assault Unit arrested a male after allegations were made by a victim, who was a teenager at the time, about offences that took place from 2014 to 2015. The historic sexual assaults took place at Team Canada Black Belt Institute on Ritson Road North in Oshawa. The suspect was the victim's instructor and sexually assaulted her on several occasions.

Matthew MITCHELL, age 30 of Ritson Road North, in Oshawa, is charged with Sexual Assault; Sexual Interference and Sexual Exploitation; He was released on an Undertaking.

Investigators want to ensure there are no other victims.

SUSPECT WANTED AFTER A TOW-TRUCK ARSON IN AJAX

Investigators are looking for the public's assistance in identifying a suspect who fled from police after a vehicle arson this morning in Ajax.

On Friday, January 8, 2021, at approximately 6:10 p.m., members of West Division responded to a vehicle fire on Gamble Drive in Ajax. Officers arrived to find a Chevrolet tow-truck fully engulfed in flames. The fire was extinguished by Ajax Fire and Emergency Services. There

were no reported injuries. Police spotted the suspect vehicle driving near the scene and attempted to pull it over. The suspect failed to stop for police and drove off at a high rate of speed. The suspect vehicle, a red/orange SUV was last seen in the area of Harwood Avenue and Kingston Road in Ajax. Investigators are treating this as an arson.

The suspect is described as male and he fled the scene in a red/orange SUV.

DRUGS AND WEAPONS SEIZED DURING SEARCH WARRANT IN OSHAWA

Investigators have arrested two suspects and seized a quantity of drugs and weapons after concluding a drug investigation in Oshawa. On Thursday, January 7, 2021, investigators from the Central East Division Criminal Investigations Bureau, with the assistance of the Tactical Support Unit and the Offender Management Unit, executed a search warrant at a residence on Mill Street in Oshawa. During the search warrant, investigators seized approximately \$90,000 in cash, drugs (cocaine, fentanyl, methamphetamine, cannabis and heroin) and numerous imitation handguns and weapons.

The suspect **KYLE ODETTE** was also charged in relation to a robbery at an Oshawa hotel on Bloor Street West on December 17, 2020. The suspect entered one of the units armed with a gun and stabbed the victim before fleeing on foot. The victim in this incident sustained non-life threatening injuries to his face.

Kyle ODETTE, age 37, of Mill Street in Oshawa is facing 17 charges including: Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking x4; Possession for Purpose of Trafficking (Cannabis); Weapons Dangerous; Assault with a Weapon; Robbery with an Offensive Weapon and Carry Concealed Weapon. He was held for a bail hearing.

Kayla DONNISON, age 33, of Centre Street North in Oshawa, is charged with Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking x4 and Possession for Purpose of Trafficking (Cannabis).
