### FEMALE CHARGED WITH CAUSING A DISTURBANCE IN PORT PERRY

A 61-year-old female has been charged with causing a disturbance at the waterfront in Port Perry.

On August 15, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. officers from North Division responded to reports of a disturbance at the waterfront in Port Perry. Eye-witnesses called to report a female yelling racial slurs at several people. When police arrived, both the female suspect and victims had left the area.

On August 16, 2021, a video of the incident was posted on social media depicting the female suspect yelling racial slurs at several victims. Upon further investigation, officers at North Division were able to identify the suspect.

A 61-year-old female of Scugog has been charged by way of a Summons with Causing a Disturbance.

### POLICE SEEKING WITNESSES IN FAIL TO REMAIN

Police are looking for two suspects who fled from a collision in Oshawa Wednesday late afternoon.

On Wednesday, September 1, 2021, at 4:30 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a collision involving two vehicles in the area of Grenfell Street and Elmgrove Avenue in Oshawa. A collision occurred in the intersection between a blue Nissan and a black Honda Civic. The two male occupants of the Honda fled on foot. The driver of the Nissan

suffered minor injuries. Further investigation revealed that the Honda Civic was a stolen vehicle.

The suspects are described as:

Suspect #1 - male, tanned complexion, late teens, long black hair. He was wearing a black hoodie, dark pants and a mask over his face.

Suspect #2 - male, black, slim build, 5'5" tall, short black hair. He was wearing a white t-shirt, blue jeans and black shoes.

### FEMALE SERIOUSLY INJURED IN COLLISION IN OSHAWA

A 29-year-old female was seriously injured after being struck by a motor vehicle while tending to an injured animal on the roadway in Oshawa.

On Thursday, September 2, 2021, at approximately 10:20 p.m., members of Central East Division were called to the scene of a collision at the intersection of Simcoe Street North and Darcy Street. The female who had stopped her vehicle to assist an injured animal and while retrieving an item from her vehicle's trunk, was struck by a Honda Civic. The female was transported by ambulance to a Toronto-area trauma centre with serious but non-life threatening injuries.

The roadway was closed for several hours while officers conducted their investigation.

### HOME INVASION ROBBERY IN OSHAWA

Investigators are looking for several suspects after a home invasion at a residence in

On Thursday, September 3, 2021, at approximately 11 p.m., members from East Division responded to a home invasion at a residence near Greenhill Avenue and Harmony Road North. Five suspects, armed with handguns forcibly entered the home. The suspects sprayed an irritant in the home and attempted to tie the victims up. During the incident, one

The unidentified male is described as male white, approximately 5'7" to 5'8" tall, 140 pounds and a shaved head. He was riding a blue and silver scooter.

### THEFT SUSPECTS ARRESTED AND GUN SEIZED IN OSHAWA

Two male suspects face numerous charges after a theft arrest led to the seizure of a firearm in Oshawa Thursday afternoon.

On Thursday, September 3, 2021, members of East Division responded to a shoplifting call at the Walmart on Harmony Road North in Oshawa. One of the suspects entered the store, selected items and left the store without paying. The suspect made his way to an awaiting white Honda Civic and both the suspect and driver were arrested. During the investigation, police located and seized a 9mm handgun.

Ryan HOLTER, age 23, of Oxford Street in Oshawa and Austin BOUDREAU, age 19, of No Fixed Address face a combined 13 charges which include: Theft under \$5,000; Mischief/Damage to Property under \$5,000; Possess Loaded Restricted/Prohibited Firearm; Occupy Motor Vehicle with Firearm; Possess Restricted/Prohibited Firearm no Licence or Registration Certificate and Possession of Property Obtained by Crime under \$5,000.

### DRUGS SEIZED DURING SEARCH WARRANTS

Investigators have arrested three suspects and seized a quantity of drugs after concluding a drug investigation in Oshawa and Bowmanville.

As part of an ongoing drug investigation, officers from the Drug Enforcement Unit, executed search warrants on Colborne Street West in Oshawa and Carey Lane in Bowmanville

During the search warrants, investigators seized approximately 50 pounds of cannabis, as well as a quantity of cocaine, fentanyl and opioids.

Hassan SAEED, age 29, of Oshawa is charged with: Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (fentanyl); Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (cocaine); and Fail to Comply with Release Order. He was held for a bail hearing.

Kirby SPEAR, age 37, of

Oshawa is charged with: Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (fentanyl) and Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (cocaine). She was released on an Undertaking.

Micklange QIAMI, age 31, of Bowmanville is charged with: Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (opioid); Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (cocaine); and Possession of Cannabis for the Purpose of Distributing.

### K-9 UNIT LOCATES BREAK AND ENTER SUSPECT IN AJAX

An 18-year-old male faces numerous charges after an attempted break and enter and a home invasion in Ajax Tuesday morning.

On Tuesday, August 31, 2021 at approximately 2:30 a.m., members of West Division were called to the area of Hewitt Crescent for reports of a break-and-enter in progress. The victim heard noises in his backyard, went to investigate and saw a male suspect, armed with a gun, attempting to break into a rear window. The suspect was unsuccessful in gaining entry and fled from the scene.

Our K-9 Unit, PSD Riot and his handler tracked the suspect along Barbour Street in Ajax where he was apprehended by PSD Riot. The male was taken to local hospital with minor injuries from a dog bite and released.

Further investigation revealed that the suspect committed a home invasion on the same street prior to the break and enter and confronted two teen residents while armed with a firearm. The suspect fled the first home without taking anything. Police searched the immediate area and located a loaded firearm.

Avante HARRISON, age 18, of Burcher Street in Ajax, is charged with: Home Invasion; Loiter/Prowl at Night x2; Attempt Break and Enter; Point Firearm x2; Assault with a Weapon x2; Possess Weapon for Committing an Offence x2; Firearm Unauthorized Possession x2; Uttering Threats of Bodily Harm and Death; Weapons Knowledge of Unauthorized Possession; Prohibited/Restricted Firearm with Ammunition; Possession of a Weapon Obtained by Crime.

victim managed to escape from a second story window. That male victim sustained a broken leg.

The other victims, a male and female suffered minor injuries. Investigators believe this was a targeted incident. The suspects fled in a vehicle stealing a cell phone prior to police arrival.

The five suspects are described as two black males, one Middle Eastern male and two white males. They all wore black clothing with black bandanas covering their faces.

Bloor Street involving an e-bike and motor vehicle. An unidentified male was operating an e-bike southbound on Courtice Road when it was struck from behind by a southbound motor vehicle. The unidentified rider was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre where he remains in critical condition. His identity is unknown. The other vehicle, a 2018 Hyundai driven by an Oshawa male, ended up in a ditch on the east side of the roadway. The driver received minor injuries and was treated at the scene.
