SUSPECT ARRESTED AND SEIZED DRUGS, AMMUNITION AND GUN IN OSHAWA

A 43-year-old male faces numerous firearm-related charges after an investigation in Oshawa Monday morning. On Monday, October 10, 2021, at approximately 11:15 a.m., members from Central East Division were called to the area of Anderson Avenue and Rideau Street for reports of an armed male in a grey Chevrolet. Officers arrived and located the suspect and the suspect vehicle. The suspect was arrested without incident and police located a loaded firearm, ammunition, cocaine and other drug paraphernalia.

Steve JOHNSON, age 43, of Alwin Circle in Pickering faces 11 criminal charges including: Possess Loaded Restricted/Prohibited Firearm; Occupy Motor Vehicle with Firearm; Possession of a Firearm Knowing Serial Number Has Been Tampered with; Transport Firearm or Restricted Weapon Contrary to Regulation and Possess Cocaine for the Purpose of Trafficking.

SUSPECTS WANTED IN STABBING INVESTIGATION IN AJAX

A 20-year-old male was taken to a local hospital after being assaulted by three males in Ajax on Saturday morning. On Saturday, October 9, 2021, at approximately 8:48 a.m., members from West Division were called to the area of Adams Drive and Ritchie Avenue for the report of a disturbance outside a residential home. Officers arrived and located the 20-year-old victim who sustained defensive wounds as a result of a knife attack. The victim was assaulted by three unknown males who pulled up in a silver four-door vehicle. The injuries were non-life threatening and he was transported to a local hospital. The suspects are described as all male, South Asian. They fled in a silver four-door vehicle.

This was not a random act. It's believed to be a targeted attack.

ALTERCATION SENDS TWO TO HOSPITAL

A 22-year-old male and a 31-year-old male were taken to hospital after being located with stab wounds in Oshawa on Monday night.

On Monday, October 11, 2021, at approximately 11 p.m., members from Central East Division were called to Centre Street and Hall Street for a stabbing. Police arrived and located the 31-year-old male with a non-life threatening stab wound and was taken to a local hospital.

A member of the K-9 Unit assisted officers with searching the area and located a second victim who had some injuries consistent with a stabbing altercation. The 22-year-old male suffered non-life threatening injuries and was treated at a local hospital. Police received little information regarding the stabbing.

The 22-year-old male of Oshawa was charged with: Assault Cause Bodily Harm; Assault with a Weapon; Carry Concealed Weapon; Possess Weapon for Committing Offence and Possess Schedule I Substance (cocaine).

The 31-year-old male of Oshawa was charged with: Assault Cause Bodily Harm; Assault with a Weapon; Carry Concealed Weapon and Possess Weapon for Committing Offence.

STOLEN VEHICLE LOCATED AND SUSPECT ARRESTED IN COURTYARD

One passenger arrested and the driver of a stolen vehicle is wanted after both fled from police during a traffic stop in Courtyard.

On Wednesday, October 6, 2021, at approximately 8 p.m., a member of East Division stopped a vehicle in the parking lot of 1403 Regional Highway #2. Police noted the license plate on the pick-up truck to be obscured. As the officer investigated the two occupants, they both fled on foot. The passenger was arrested without incident. The 2004 Chevrolet Silverado was a stolen vehicle from the Durham area.

Christopher FARROW, age 30, of Oshawa is charged with: Theft of Motor Vehicle; Possess Property Obtained by Crime under \$5,000 and Fail to Comply with Release Order x2.

STOLEN VEHICLE LOCATED AND SUSPECTS ARRESTED IN OSHAWA

Two suspects were arrested in a stolen vehicle in Oshawa. On Thursday, October 7, 2021, at approximately 1 a.m., members of Central West Division located a stolen vehicle in the parking lot of 680

Laval Drive. The stolen white Honda Civic was stolen in Owen Sound. The driver and passenger whom were in the vehicle, were arrested without incident. Police also seized a black BB-gun.

D'Angelo MCWATCH, age 24, of Owen Sound is charged with: Possess Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5,000; Fail to Comply with Probation Order x4 and Fail to Comply with Undertaking.

Travis SLOAN, age 27, of Owen Sound is charged with: Possess Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5,000 and Fail to Comply with Probation Order x2.

ONE SERIOUSLY INJURED IN OSHAWA SHOOTING

Investigators have arrested two suspects in a shooting investigation that took place in downtown Oshawa on September 9, 2021.

On Thursday, September 9, 2021, at approximately 11:50 a.m., members of Central East Division responded to a shooting at the intersection of Ritson Road North and Bond Street East. Officers arrived on scene and located a 25-year-old male suffering from

gunshot wounds. The victim was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre with serious but non-life threatening injuries.

On Friday, October 1, 2021, investigators arrested a 34-year-old male in Barrie and on Wednesday, October 6, 2021, they arrested a 36-year-old male in Woodbridge.

Dana WILLIAMS, age 34, and **Jermaine WEEKES**, age 36, both of Ajax are charged with:

Attempt Murder, Aggravated Assault, Discharge Firearm with Intent and Possession of a Restricted/Prohibited Firearm with Ammunition.

ONE MALE ARRESTED IN UNLICENSED/UNREGISTERED CLINIC IN OSHAWA

Investigators are looking for victims or patients who may have health concerns to come forward after an unlicensed/unregistered clinic was located in Oshawa.

On Wednesday, October 6, 2021 members of the DRPS - Financial Crimes Unit completed an investigation in relation to a suspected unlicensed

and unregistered cosmetic surgery clinic being operated in a private residence. The primary suspected procedures were Botox, non-surgical nose augmentations, fillers and hair transplant surgeries. Investigators executed a search warrant at a residence on Pilgrim Square in Oshawa, working in conjunction with The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, Durham Region Health Department, and Durham EMS. The suspect was arrested in the residence without incident.

Police seized numerous documents and evidence at the scene.

Isaac ACEVEDA, age 51, of Pilgrim Square in Oshawa is charged with: False Pretense Over \$5000.

MALE CHARGED WITH FRAUD

A 22-year-old male has been charged with fraud after selling fake magic trading cards online.

In March of 2021, the victim purchased several Magic Cards from the suspect through an online platform. Shortly after the purchase, the victim received confirmation

that the cards were not authentic. The suspect sold the Magic Cards on Facebook Marketplace under the name AJ Bsis. The victim was defrauded of more than \$1,500.

Investigators believe there may be other victims that have not come forward to police.

Ayub BSIS, age 22 of Oshawa, is charged with: Fraud Under \$5,000 x 2; and Passing Off Wares x 2.

TWO MALES CHARGED AFTER STABBING IN OSHAWA

Two males have been charged after a stabbing incident in Oshawa on Saturday evening.

On Saturday, October 2, 2021, at approximately 8:50 p.m., members from Central East Division were called to the area of Adelaide Avenue West and Park Road North. A male and female were exiting their vehicle when two males confronted them and attempted to taser them. The suspects were unsuccessful and then proceeded to spray the male and female with bear spray. One of the suspects was stabbed by the male victim during the altercation. The two suspects fled on foot.

Police located one of the suspects at a local hospital with serious but non-life threatening injuries as a result of a stab wound. The suspect, a 27-year-old male of Clarington was charged with: Assault with a Weapon x2. He was held for a bail hearing.

The male victim, a 32-year-old male of Oshawa was also charged with: Assault with a Weapon, Assault Cause Bodily Harm and Possession of a Weapon Dangerous to Public Peace. He was released on an Undertaking.
