## CLOCA Notice: Watershed Conditions Statement – Flood Outlook

The Central Lake Ontario Conservation Authority advises that the Ministry of Natural Resources Surface Water Monitoring Centre (MNRF SWMC) is forecasting incoming weather systems that will bring periods of rain into the area over the next few days. It is expected that we will see rainfall amounts of approximately 30-60mm over the course of Thursday, Friday, and into Saturday. Thunderstorms associated with this event are possible and may produce an additional 5- 10mm in isolated areas.

Current flow conditions combined with incoming significant precipitation amounts will result in higher than normal water levels and flows in all our streams and creeks, resulting in dangerous flow conditions especially in the vicinity of culverts and bridges. Localized flooding can be expected on roadways, in low lying and flood prone areas.

The Central Lake Ontario Conservation Authority is asking all residents and children to stay away from all watercourses and structures such as bridges, culverts and dams. Elevated water levels, fast flowing water, and slippery conditions along stream banks continue to make these locations extremely dangerous.

According to an advanced briefing released yesterday ahead of this storm system, the Lake Ontario- St. Lawrence River Board is advising that the effects of the upcoming storm will be more severe near the Ottawa River, but that Lake Ontario and the surrounding basin could be impacted. Current conditions on Lake Ontario have the water level at 75.11m, which is 21cm above average. There is considerable uncertainty in forecast water supplies to Lake Ontario, the effects that Ottawa River flows will have on lower St. Lawrence River levels, and by extension, outflows from Lake Ontario, all of which will factor into the water level response on Lake Ontario. Nonetheless, there is potential for a significant and rapid rise in Lake Ontario water levels, particularly during the next two weeks. Current forecasts suggest a 50% chance that levels will rise at least 20cm during that time, with the potential for a greater rise under the wettest scenarios.

This Watershed Conditions Statement – Flood Outlook will be in effect through Tuesday, April 23, 2019. The Central Lake Ontario Conservation Authority will continue to monitor the conditions of the streams and creeks and will provide updates as required.
