



Male Arrested after Attempting to Flee **From Police**

distraught 26-year-old Bowmanville male was arrested after fleeing from police and crashing his vehicle in Bowmanville.

On Saturday, September 8, 2018, at approximately 11:10 p.m. officers from East Division responded to the area of Clarington Concession Road 8 and Highway 115/35 for a distraught male driving in that area. Police located the suspect who was operating a blue Pontiac and attempted to stop the vehicle. The suspect refused to stop and sped away. Officers were concerned for the male's wellbeing and deployed a tire-deflation device to stop the vehicle. The suspect vehicle continued to drive at a high rate of speed with deflated tires and struck a black Volkswagen Atlas at Liberty Street and Clarington Concession Road 3 in Bowmanville. The suspect vehicle ended up in the

The 36-year-old Clarington driver of the Volkswagen and his five passengers did not suffer injuries.

The 26-year-old was transported to a local area hospital with a minor head injury.

The 26-year-old male from Bowmanville faces several charges including: Impaired Operation; Fail to Stop for Police; Dangerous Operation and Drive While under Suspension. He was taken to a local hospital for a mental health evaluation and then held for a bail hearing

Members of the DRPS Traffic Services Branch, Collision Investigation Unit, attended the scene to conduct an investigation. The scene was closed for several hours while evidence was collected.

Stolen Vehicle Would **Not Stop**

A stolen vehicle drove through construction signs, over a sidewalk, across a grassy boulevard and over a roadway median in an effort to avoid officers.

On Monday, September 3, 2018 at approximately 9:30 a.m., officers patrolling north

Ajax observed a white pickup truck make an illegal turn from Brock Road onto Highway 7. As they followed the vehicle eastbound on Highway 7, they determined it had been reported stolen. They followed the pickup from a safe distance and called upon other units to assist with a rolling

After activating their overhead lights and attempting to box the vehicle in on Baldwin Street south of Highway 407 in north Whitby, the vehicle drove off the roadway and sped away. The vehicle then drove through two construction traffic signs on the gravel shoulder on Baldwin Street, which damaged the windshield and resulted in a blown back tire. The pickup then continued southbound to Taunton Road, where it turned westbound and struck a responding police cruiser. The pickup then drove over the roadway median and entered the parking lot of a plaza, where it was boxed in. The driver was arrested and later, provided a false identity to officers.

There were no injuries as a result of this brief pursuit and only minor damage to a police cruiser.

A 39-year-old Oshawa male was rushed to hospital early this morning with serious injuries after a stabbing incident in Oshawa.

On Saturday, Sept 1, 2018 at approx. 2:00 a.m., the male was involved in a physical altercation near the intersection of King Street East and Mary Street North in Oshawa. The male was taken to a Toronto trauma centre with serious injuries. Suspects fled the scene following the altercation.


Male Injured By A **Break and Enter** Suspect
