

Teenaged Pedestrian Suffers Serious Injuries in Clarington

A 14-year-old male was seriously injured after being struck by a vehicle in Claringont.

On Thursday, October 12, 2018, at approximately 7:00 p.m., members from East Division were called to a serious collision involving a vehicle and a pedestrian at Simpson Avenue and King Street East in Clarington. The 14-year-old male was on his skateboard when he entered the roadway and was struck by a four-door Hyundai that was travelling southbound on Simpson Avenue.

First responders attended the scene within minutes and provided medical assistance to the teenager. The male was transported to local hospital and then taken to a Torontoarea hospital with serious

njuries.

The roadway was shut down for the investigation. The area of the roadway was closed for several hours while evidence was collected.

Suspect Wanted after Stabbing Incident in Oshawa

A suspect is being sought after a male was stabbed during an altercation at a restaurant in Oshawa last week.

On Friday September 21

On Friday, September 21, 2018, at approximately 10:45 pm., members of Central East Division responded to a McDonald's restaurant on Simcoe Street North in Oshawa for a young male suffering a laceration. Police received information that an altercation had taken place inside the restaurant and that an 18-year-old male had been injured during the incident. The victim received medical treatment and was later released from hospital.

The suspect is described as: male, white, 18-20's, approximately 5'6" tall, slim build, wearing a blue hooded "Nike" windbreaker, white "Champion" shirt, blue jeans

windbreaker, white "Champion" shirt, blue jeans and black and white running shoes.

Suspects Wanted after Thefts from Burial Plots in Whitby

Police are looking to identify suspect(s) after over 100 brass vases were stolen from burial plots in Whitby last week.

Sometime between Wednesday, October 3, 2018 and Saturday, October 6, 2018, a large quantity of brass vases were stolen from burial plots at Mount Lawn Cemetery located on Garrard Road in Whitby. The suspects entered the property and made off with several hundred vases. There is no suspect(s) descriptors at this time.

the public's assistance in trying to identify the suspect(s). Three Males Arrested After an Altercation in Oshawa

Three suspects are facing charges after a disturbance in Oshawa Sunday night.

On Sunday, October 7, 2018, at approximately 11:20 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to Bloor Street East near Ritson Road South in Oshawa for a fight call. Police arrived and located a male party with serious head injuries. The male was taken to a local hospital with non-life threatening injuries. A second male was also located with a knife wound to his hands and he was taken to local hospital with non-life threatening injuries. It appears that there was a physical altercation between the two males and another male at the time of the incident.

Further investigation revealed that the same males were involved in a previous altercation on Saturday October 6, 2018. During that incident, BROOKS pointed an imitation firearm at one of the males and threatened him.

Joshua COUSINS, age 23, of Bloor Street in Oshawa is charged with Assault Cause Bodily Harm and Weapons Dangerous. He was held for a bail hearing.

Jesse BROOKS, age 28, of Glen Street in Oshawa is charged with: Assault Cause Bodily Harm x2; Weapons Dangerous x3; Point Firearm; Threaten Death; Possession of a Controlled Substance for the Purpose of

Trafficking(cocaine); Possession of Firearm Contrary to Order x4; Fail to Comply with Probation x6 and Fail to Comply with an Undertaking x3. He was held for a bail hearing.

Zachary DERRICK, age 26 of Glen Street in Oshawa is charged with; Assault; Assault Cause Bodily Harm and Weapons Dangerous.

Suspect Wanted after a Street-Level Robbery in Pickering

A suspect is being sought after a male was robbed of his jewelry In Pickering on Sunday morning.

On Sunday, October 7, 2018, at approximately 4:30 a.m., members of West Division responded to a residential complex at Whites Road and Finch Avenue in Pickering for a robbery. The victim advised that he arrived at his resi-

dence and was approached by an unknown male who demanded his jewelry. He believed that the suspect was armed with a gun. He complied and then went into his residence to call police. The suspect fled in a nearby vehi-

The victim didn't sustain any physical injuries.

The suspect is described as: male, black, approximately 25 to 29 years of age, medium build, 5'7" tall, moustache, unshaven, black hair. He was wearing a grey-hooded sweatshirt. It is believed that a second suspect was waiting in a vehicle.

There is no description of the second party or the vehicle at this time.
