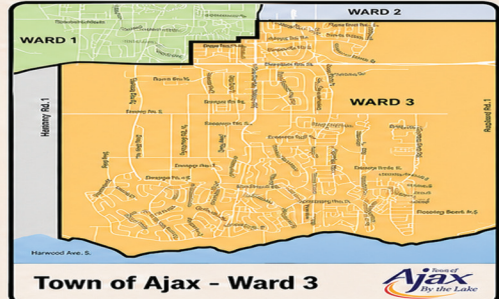

COMMUNITY LEADERS SPEAK ON TRUMP’S TARIFF WAR

It appears that all community leaders are up in arms due to the recent announcement of Tariff attack. **Regional Chair John Henry:** “We’re deeply disappointed by the United States’ decision to proceed with targeted 50 per cent tariffs on Canadian goods. At a time when businesses and workers on both sides of the border benefit from a strong economic partnership, these measures create uncertainty and put additional pressure on communities that rely on cross-border trade. We stand with the federal government’s response and support measures to defend Canadian interests, workers and industries, and our top priority is protecting Durham Region businesses. To support these efforts, we’re bringing together the Durham Economic Task Force to assess the impact on businesses across Durham, explore ways partners can work together to provide support and ensure businesses have access to timely information and resources. I encourage residents to support local businesses, choose Canadian-made products whenever possible and invest in the people that drive Durham Region’s economy.”

Clarington Mayor Adrian Foster: “We stand strong with our business community against these unjustified and senseless trade tariffs. For decades, the strength of Canada and the United States has depended on shared economic partnerships. Canadians and local businesses deserve better. Clarington continues to prioritize local procurement through the Clarington Vendor Directory, which connects local businesses with municipal opportunities. We buy local, buy Ontario, buy Canadian, whenever we can through procurement policies.”

Oshawa Mayor Dan Carter: “The City of Oshawa is disappointed by the breakdown in trade negotiations between Canada and the United States and the resulting tariffs now being imposed on Canadian goods. These measures create uncertainty for businesses, workers and families on both sides of the border and will be felt across industries that have long benefited from a strong and mutually beneficial trading relationship..”

Whitby Mayor Elizabeth Roy: “Today’s remarks from Premier Doug Ford underscore the seriousness of the escalating trade dispute with the United States and the need for all levels of government to stand together in defence of Canadian workers and businesses.”

Ajax Mayor Shaun Collier: “It’s one threat after another from the President. Now he wants to rename Lake Ontario “Lake America”? It’s not only absurd, it’s an insult to the history and identity of the communities like Ajax who share this Great Lake. This trade war may be about power for the President, but for local businesses, it’s about uncertainty, rising costs and real anxiety.”

Pickering Mayor Kevin Ashe: “Recent developments in Canada-U.S. trade relations continue to create uncertainty for businesses, workers, and communities across the country, including here in Pickering. As the federal and provincial governments introduce new and expanded tariff relief programs and economic support measures, the City is actively evaluating these opportunities and working with Durham Region, local business organizations, and industry partners to help connect businesses with available funding, resources, and assistance.”

Scugog Mayor Wilma Wotten: “Canada and the United States have long built their economic success on collaboration, shared prosperity, and strong cross-border partnerships. We cannot afford to lose sight of that. The recent U.S. tariff announcement and Canada’s response will have real impacts on businesses and families here in Scugog..”
