THREE SUSPECTS WANTED AFTER ATTEMPTED CAR THEFT IN PICKERING

Three suspects are wanted after an attempted car theft in Pickering.

On Wednesday, January 16, 2025, at approximately 5:20 a.m., members of West Division responded to an attempted car theft in the area of Bronte Square and Glendale Drive. Three suspects attempted to steal a Toyota pick-up truck from a residential driveway. The suspects were unsuccessful and fled the area in a white Range Rover SUV.

A short time later, officers located the white Range Rover SUV unoccupied in the area of Rougemount Drive and Altona Road. The vehicle had visible front-end damage and may have been involved in a collision.

SUSPECTS SOUGHT AFTER INCENDIARY DEVICES THROWN AT RESIDENCE IN OSHAWA

Police are seeking two suspects after two incendiary devices were thrown at a residence in Oshawa.

On Wednesday, January 15, 2025 at approximately 8:40 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to the area of Valley Drive and Phillip Murray Avenue for two suspicious packages that were thrown at a residence. Two suspects arrived at the residence in a dark coloured pickup truck, which they used to break the front door of the residence. The suspects then threw a package through the front door and a second package at a window. Officers arrived and located the two packages. Residences in the area were evacuated while members of the Explosive Device Unit (EDU) were called in to assist.

The packages were found to be incendiary devices and were rendered safe by EDU. The suspect vehicle is described as a dark coloured pickup truck with chrome trim and chrome gas cap cover.

MALE ARRESTED WITH LOADED HANDGUN IN OSHAWA

A 22-year-old male was arrested with a loaded handgun following a drug and firearm investigation in Oshawa.

On Wednesday, January 15, 2025 members of the Gun and Gang Enforcement Unit completed an investigation into drug trafficking and unlawful firearms. The suspect was arrested at a shopping plaza in the area of Laval Drive and Stevenson Road South. During the arrest officers located a loaded semi-automatic firearm in his jacket.

A search warrant was executed at the suspect's residence in the area of Dean Avenue and Normandy Street, resulting in the seizure of an over-capacity magazine, more than 240g of cocaine and more than 350g of fentanyl with a street value in excess of \$100,000.

Antonio NIKOLAKAKIS, age 22, of Oshawa is charged with: Possess Loaded Regulated Firearm; Possess Prohibited Device Knowing No Authority and Possess Schedule I Substance for Trafficking x2 (fentanyl and cocaine).

POLICE SEEKING FIVE SUSPECTS AFTER PICKERING SHOOTING

Five suspects are wanted after a shooting left a youth injured on Tuesday night in Pickering.

On Tuesday, January 14, 2025, at approximately 10:05 p.m., members of West Division responded to the area of Kingston Road and Valley Farm Road for a victim that had been shot. Officers arrived on scene and located the victim suffering from a bullet wound. The victim was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre but has since been released with non-life-threatening injuries. Five suspects had fled on foot prior to police arrival.

An investigation determined the shooting occurred in a residential complex at 1580 Kingston Road, Pickering. Officers located one resi-

dence that had been shot. There were no further physical injuries reported.

Suspect #1 is described as wearing a dark coloured hooded sweater, dark pants and black shoes.

Suspect #2 is described as wearing a light-coloured sweater with dark shoulders and dark pants.

Suspect #3 is described as wearing a grey sweater and grey pants.

Suspect #4 is described as wearing a white jacket, dark pants and bright shoes.

Suspect #5 is described as wearing a white hat, grey jacket, grey pants and black shoes.

13-YEAR-OLD CYCLIST STRUCK IN AJAX

Officers have laid charges against the driver involved in a fatal collision involving a 13-year-old cyclist in Ajax.

On Thursday, November 7, 2024, members from West Division were dispatched to a collision involving a cyclist and motor vehicle on Stevensgate Drive near Rossland Road West in Ajax. It was reported that a black 2020 Hyundai Sante Fe was turning from Stevensgate Drive onto Rossland Road West when it struck a cyclist riding westbound through a marked crossride. The rider of the bicycle, a 13-year-old female from Ajax was fatally injured as a result of the collision. The driver of the Hyundai was uninjured and remained on the scene. Police attended and conducted an investigation.

On Monday January 13th, 2025, the driver of the Hyundai was charged by police. The driver, a 44-year-old female from Ajax was charged with Careless Driving Causing Death under the Highway Traffic Act.

SERIOUS INJURY COLLISION

Police have concluded an investigation that left a driver with serious injuries. A 24-year-old driver is now facing charges.

On Saturday July 20, 2024 at approximately 6:55 p.m., members from North Division responded to a collision involving a pick-up truck and a motorcycle at the intersection of Regional Road 57 and Nestleton Road in the Township of Scugog. The motorcycle struck the rear right corner of the Chevrolet pickup, ejecting the 65-year-old male from the motorcycle. The driver of the motorcycle was transported to a Toronto area trauma centre with life-threatening injuries.

Nicholous SEENEY, age 24 from Oshawa is charged with: Careless Driving Cause Bodily Harm, and Operate Unsafe Motor Vehicle.

MALE ARRESTED AFTER BREAK-AND-ENTER AT OSHAWA CANADIAN TIRE

A male is facing charges after breaking into a Canadian Tire in Oshawa.

On Tuesday, December 24, 2024, at approximately 5:10 a.m., members of Central East Division responded to a break-and-enter in progress at the Canadian Tire automotive store, located at 1333 Wilson Road North. A male suspect broke into the business and attempted to steal merchandise. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect who fled the area on foot. Officers engaged in a short foot pursuit before taking the suspect into custody.

The suspect was linked to a

previous break-and-enter at the same location.

Tyler Leo LAZURE, age 40 from Oshawa is charged with: Break-and-Enter x2, and Fail to Comply with Probation Order x2.

MALE ARRESTED FOLLOWING HUMAN TRAFFICKING INVESTIGATION

A male is facing charges after the completion of a human trafficking investigation.

On Monday, December 30, 2024, members of the Human Trafficking Unit (HTU), attended the area of York Street and Bremner Boulevard, in Toronto, in relation to an ongoing investigation. A male believed to be trafficking a 15-year-old female from Durham Region, was located and taken into custody without incident. Subsequently, a search warrant was conducted on the suspect's residence leading to the seizure of drugs and cash.

Shaun FAIRFAX, age 25 of No Fixed Address is charged with: Trafficking in Person Under 18, Material Benefit from Trafficking in Persons Under 18, Material Benefit from Sexual Services Under 18, Advertise Another Person Sexual Services, House Holder Permitting Prohibited Sexual Activity, and Procuring Under 18.

TWO ARRESTED AFTER BREAK-AND-ENTER IN WHITBY

Two males are in custody after breaking into a residence in Whitby.

On Tuesday, December 24, 2024, at approximately 5:55 a.m., members of Central West Division responded to a break-and-enter at a residence in the area of Princess Street and Cassels Road East. Two males used a stolen garage door remote to access the garage of a residence. Officers arrived on scene and took one male into custody without incident. The second male fled the area in a grey SUV.

Officers searched the area and later located the suspect vehicle. A traffic stop was initiated and the second suspect was taken into custody without incident.

Zachary LINTNER, age 33 from Courtice is charged with: Break-and-Enter, Possess Property Obtained by Crime Under \$5000, Fail to Comply with Release Order, and Fail to Comply with Probation Order x2.

Joseph DAVRIEUX, age 55 from Clarington is charged with: Break-and-Enter, Dangerous Operation, Flight from Police, Operate a Conveyance While Prohibited, and Fail to Comply with Release Order x2.

MALE ARMED WITH SHOTGUN ARRESTED AFTER MAKING THREATS IN OSHAWA

A male is in custody after he made threats with a shotgun outside a residence in Oshawa.

On Tuesday, December 17, 2024, at approximately 12:50 p.m., members of Central West Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Thornton Road North and Winchester Road West. A male made threats with a shotgun toward three other males who attended the property to enforce an eviction. The three victims exited the property and contacted police. Officers arrived on scene and located the suspect barricaded inside of his residence. Police set up containment and closed the roadways as they negotiated with the male. After lengthy negotiations, the suspect safely surrendered himself to police and was taken into custody without incident. A shotgun, rifle, and ammunition were seized following a search of the residence.

The victims did not sustain any physical injuries.

Steven Rejean COTE, age 64 of Whitby is charged with: Possess Firearm - No licence x9, Careless Use of a Firearm x2, Possession of a Firearm with Ammunition x2, Possession of a Prohibited Device x2, Utter Threats, and Assault with a Weapon.
