Impaired Male Arrested with Firearm after Fleeing Traffic Stop in Ajax

A male is facing impaired operation and firearm charges after fleeing from police during a traffic stop in Ajax.

On Wednesday, June 3, 2026, at approximately 7:40 p.m., members of West Division on proactive patrol initiated a traffic stop in the area of Audley Road and Kerrison Drive. Officers observed signs of impairment and demanded the driver exit the vehicle, however the driver failed to comply and fled from police at a high rate of speed. Officers did not pursue the vehicle.

A short time later, with the assistance of AIR1, officers located the suspect after he exited the suspect vehicle and was picked up by another vehicle. A second traffic stop was initiated on the second vehicle, and officers took the suspect into custody. During the arrest, a loaded firearm with laser sight and prohibited extended magazine was located in the suspect's waistband.

At the time of his arrest the accused was bound by a lifetime weapons prohibition.

Roy PALMER, age 38 from Toronto is charged with: Dangerous Operation, Flight from Peace Officer, Impaired Operation, Impaired Operation – Exceed, Possess Loaded Firearm, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Firearm – No Licence, Possess Restricted/Prohibited Firearm Knowingly No Authority, Unlicensed Possession of Prohibited/Restricted Firearm x2, Possess Firearm Contrary to Prohibition Order x2, and Occupy Vehicle with Firearm.

A Male Arrested After Sexual Assault and Exploitation Investigation in Whitby

A male is facing charges following a sexual assault and exploitation investigation in Whitby.

On Wednesday, May 27, 2026, investigators with the DRPS Special Victims Unit concluded an investigation into an adult male who report-

edly sexually assaulted and exploited a 16-year-old female in 2021. The victim was employed by the suspect between July 2021 and October 2021 in Whitby. Police have concerns there are other victims and are requesting anyone with information to come forward.

Ahmed ASHRAF, age 65 from Whitby is charged with: Sexual Assault x3, and Sexual Exploitation x3.

Male Arrested After Making Anti-Semitic Death Threats Online

The DRPS Hate Crime and Extremism Unit has arrested a male after he made several anti-Semitic online death threats.

In May 2026, Investigators from the DRPS East Division Criminal Investigations Branch and Hate Crime and Extremism Unit were contacted by the Vancouver Police Department after receiving information related to an account that made numerous anti-Semitic death threats via the online platform 'X'.

Investigators identified the suspect and on Tuesday, June 2, 2026, executed a search warrant at the suspect's residence in Clarington. The suspect was located inside the residence and taken into custody without incident.

David Edward SMITH, age 58 from Clarington is charged with: Uttering Death Threats.

Suspect Wanted After Armed Robbery at Convenience Store in Bowmanville

Police are searching for a suspect after an armed robbery at a convenience store in Bowmanville.

On Monday, June 1, 2026, at approximately 2:15 a.m., members of East Division responded to a robbery call at the Circle K convenience store located at 100 Mearns Avenue. A male entered the business and demanded cash from the register while threatening an employee with a knife. The suspect fled the area on foot prior to police arrival.

The victim did not suffer any physical injuries.

Suspects Wanted After Robbery in Ajax

Police are looking for two suspects after an elderly female was robbed in Ajax.

On Sunday, May 17, 2026, at approximately 4:30 p.m., members of West Division responded to a robbery call outside of a residence in the area of Old Harwood Avenue and Bray Drive. A 76-year-old female was outside of her home gardening when a vehicle being driven by a male suspect stopped in front of her residence. A female suspect exited the vehicle and assaulted the victim, stealing several gold bracelets and a necklace she was wearing, before throwing fake jewellery at the victim and fleeing the area. The victim suffered minor injuries.

Male Suffers Injuries After Dirt Bike Collision in Clarington

Male in stable but serious condition following single dirt bike collision in Clarington. On Friday, May 15, 2026, at approximately 11:00 a.m., members of East Division responded to a single vehicle accident on the unmaintained section of Boundary Road near Enfield Road. The 73-year-old male rider was driving his dirt bike eastbound on the unmaintained portion of Boundary Road near Enfield Road when he lost control and struck a tree off the roadway/trail. He was transported to a Toronto-area trauma center where he remains in serious but stable condition.

Further investigation revealed that the stabbing had initially occurred in a nearby field, approximately one hour prior to police locating the male.

Male Arrested for Vehicle Ownership Fraud in Whitby

A male is facing charges after attempting to fraudulently transfer vehicle ownerships in Whitby.

On Thursday, May 28, 2026, at approximately 3:30 p.m., members of Central West Division responded to a fraud in progress call at the Service Ontario located at 1615 Dundas Street East. A male attended the Service Ontario and attempted to register several vehicles not in his name to a third party. The accused had previously

At approximately 6:35 p.m., the 63-year-old female victim was on the sidewalk outside of her residence when a grey/silver four-door SUV pulled up along side her. A male and female suspect spoke 'broken hindi' to call the victim over to their vehicle. The female suspect in the passenger seat grabbed the victim's arm to place rings on her fingers, and removed a necklace the victim was wearing, while the male suspect distracted her. The suspects then threw fake jewellery at the victim before fleeing the area in their vehicle. The victim did not suffer any physical injuries.

The first suspect is described as: male, approximately 40-45 years-old, with a light mous-
