Single Vehicle Collision in Uxbridge

Two suffered serious injuries following a single vehicle collision in Uxbridge. On Wednesday, May 6, 2026, at approximately 3:55 a.m., members of North Division responded to a single vehicle collision in the area of Allbright Road and Uxbridge Concession Road 6. A 26-year-old male was driving a Porsche SUV east-bound on Allbright Road when it left the roadway landing in the woods. Both the driver and the 24-year-old female passenger were able to exit the vehicle before it caught fire. They were transported to a local area hospital with serious non-life-threatening injuries. The driver has since been released from hospital. The female has been transferred to a Toronto-area trauma centre.

Male Arrested for Assault Following Road Rage Incident in Ajax

A male has been arrested following an investigation into a road rage incident that occurred in Ajax. On Friday, May 1, 2026, at approximately 3:50 p.m., in the area of Kingston Road West and Westney Road South, the drivers of two vehicles were engaged in a road rage altercation. The suspect subsequently stopped his vehicle in front of the victim's vehicle and approached the victim on foot. The suspect assaulted the victim through his vehicle window before fleeing the area in his vehicle. On Saturday, May 2, 2026, members of West Division identified and located the suspect, who was taken into custody without incident. **William Alexander MARTIN**, age 35 from Ajax is charged with: Assault.

Excavator Used During Break-and-Enter at Bank in Ajax

Police are investigating after an excavator was used during a break-and-enter at a bank in Ajax. On Monday, May 4, 2026, at approximately 4:20 a.m., members of West Division responded to a commercial alarm at the TD Bank located

at 83 Williamson Drive. Officers arrived on scene and observed a parked unoccupied construction excavator near an area of the building with extensive damage. At least one ATM was stolen from the damaged area of the bank. All suspects fled the area prior to police arrival.

Suspects Sought Following Home Invasion in Pickering

Police are looking for at least three suspects following a home invasion in Pickering. At approximately 10:05 p.m., on Saturday, May 2, 2026, members of West Division responded to a break-and-enter call at a residence in the area of Apricot Lane and Skyridge Boulevard. At least three suspects broke into the residence and assaulted tenants before stealing multiple items and fleeing the area in a vehicle.

Home Invasion in Ajax

Police are searching for at least three suspects after a home invasion in Ajax. On Wednesday, April 29, 2026, at approximately 4:45 a.m., members of West Division responded to a break-and-enter call at a residence in the area of Boyd Crescent and Littler Lane. At least three suspects broke into the residence and assaulted the tenants before fleeing the area in a vehicle.

Male Arrested After Used Vehicle Oil Scam in Uxbridge

A male is facing charges after using an oil scam to fraudulently purchase a vehicle at a lower value from a seller. On Monday, April 27, 2026, the victim arranged to meet with a suspect in Uxbridge after listing a vehicle for sale on Facebook Marketplace. Following a test drive, the suspect poured engine oil onto the engine while a second suspect distracted the victim. The suspects then claimed the engine was blown and leaking oil, significantly reducing the value of the vehicle. As a result, the victim agreed to sell the vehicle for substantially less than the original asking price. On Friday, May 1, 2026, police became aware that the same vehicle had been listed on Facebook Marketplace at

nearly its original price. The listing also showed an odometer reading approximately half of the vehicle's legitimate mileage.

Later that day, investigators from the Financial Crimes Unit located and arrested the suspect without incident. The accused is also currently wanted on multiple warrants by San Jose Police Department in California.

Mogos CONSTANTIN, age 38 from Romania is charged with: Fraud Over \$5000, Mischief, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000, Traffic in Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000, Alter the Odometer of a Motor Vehicle, and Use Plate Not Authorized for Motor Vehicle. CONSTANTIN is also known to go by the alias 'Catalin IONASCU'

Arson Damages Three Homes Under Construction in Pickering

Three homes still under construction have been damaged following an arson in Pickering. On Sunday, May 3, 2026, at approximately 5:40 a.m., members of West Division responded to an assist fire call in the area of Catalina Manor and Alexander Knox Road. Officers arrived on scene and assisted fire services with traffic control as they worked to extinguish three active fires. All homes were under construction and unoccupied at the time of the fire. No injuries have been reported to police. Further investigation revealed that at approximately 5:15 a.m., three persons of interest were seen in the area.

Three Arrested After Firearm and Drug Investigation

Three males are facing charges after a drug trafficking and firearm investigation by the DRPS Gun and Gang Unit. On Thursday, April 30, 2026, investigators with the DRPS

Gun and Gang Unit concluded a drug trafficking and firearm investigation involving three males.

Gun and Gang Unit investigators, with the assistance of the Tactical Support Unit, and Drug Enforcement Unit, executed search warrants at three residences in Ajax, Whitby, and Oshawa. As a result, a loaded Glock firearm, a loaded prohibited extended magazine, a sawed-off prohibited rifle, cash, and drugs were located and seized.

Carlos Jose FRANCIS, age 19 from Whitby is charged with: Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (fentanyl) x2, Possess Prohibited/Restricted Firearm - No licence, and Possess Loaded Prohibited/Restricted Firearm.

Jahsiah GAMBLE, age 19 from Ajax is charged with: Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (fentanyl), Possess Prohibited/Restricted Firearm - No Licence, Possess Prohibited/Restricted Device, and Possess Prohibited/Restricted Firearm.

A 17-year-old male from Whitby is charged with: Possession of Schedule I Substance for the Purpose of Trafficking (fentanyl), and Fail to Comply with Release Order.

At this time of his arrest, the 17-year-old male was already bound by curfew conditions.

Youth Arrested After Brandishing Imitation Firearm in Oshawa

A female youth is facing charges after brandishing an imitation firearm during an altercation in Oshawa. On Thursday, April 23, 2026, at approximately 5:50 p.m., members of Central West Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Bridle Road and Northern Dancer Drive. A female youth brandished a firearm with an extended magazine to other youth after being involved in a verbal altercation. The sus-

pect fled the area prior to police arrival.

A short time later, officers located the suspect and took her into custody without incident. A search warrant was subsequently executed at a residence in the area, where officers seized a firearm that was confirmed to be an imitation Glock with extended magazine.

A 13-year-old female from Ajax is charged with: Possess Weapon Dangerous.

Male Arrested After Assaulting Three Victims in Bowmanville

A male is facing charges after he assaulted two males and a female in unprovoked attacks in Bowmanville.

On Tuesday, April 28, 2026, at approximately 7:40 a.m., members of East Division responded to an assault call in the area of Mearns Avenue and Apple Blossom Avenue. Police received multiple reports that an unknown male had assaulted three persons separately in unprovoked attacks. Officers located the male on foot in the area and took him into custody without incident.

The victims, a 19-year-old male, 21-year-old female, and 50-year-old male, suffered minor injuries **Dilaksan VIJEYAPALAN**, age 24 from Clarington is charged with: Assault x3.

On Friday, April 24, 2026, at approximately 12:25 p.m., members of West Division responded to a robbery call at the Shoppers Drug Mart located inside The Shops at Pickering City Centre at 1355 Kingston Road. A male entered the store and concealed several items in a bag. When the suspect was confronted by staff he fled the store. When mall security attempted to follow the male, he threatened them with a large knife.

A short time later, officers located the male and took him into custody without incident. **Jarmanjit SINGH**, age 28 from Brampton is charged with: Possess Weapon Dangerous, Theft Under \$5000 x2, Possess Property Obtained by Crime Under \$5000 x2, and Breach Probation.

A female is facing charges after stabbing another female in Pickering

On Friday, April 24, 2026, at approximately 7:15 a.m., members of West Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Kingston Road and Liverpool Road. Two females were involved in an altercation when one of them brandished a knife and stabbed the other. The suspect attempted to flee the area but was located by police and taken into custody
