Male Arrested After Voyeurism Incident in Newcastle

Police have arrested a male following a voyeurism incident at a Newcastle Recreation Centre.

On Thursday, April 9, 2026, between approximately 8:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m., at the Dianne Harne Recreation Centre located at 1780 Rudell Road, a male suspect in the male changeroom pulled open the privacy curtain to a shower where the 12-year-old victim was showering. The victim closed the curtain, however the suspect repeatedly opened the shower curtain. The victim exited the shower and was followed by the suspect, who then attempted to initiate a conversation. The victim fled the changeroom and later advised a waiting parent.

Through investigation, members of the East Division Criminal Investigations Branch identified a suspect. On April 18, 2026, the suspect was arrested at his home without incident.

Eugene Gareau, age 65 years, of Clarington is charged with: Secretly Observe/Record a Person Nude and Expose Genitals to a Person Under 16 Years of Age for a Sexual Purpose. Police have concerns there may be other victims and are releasing a photo of the accused.

Suspect Wanted After Armed Robberies in Oshawa

A male is wanted following an investigation into two armed robberies at convenience stores in Oshawa.

On Tuesday, April 14, 2026, at approximately 10:15 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a robbery call at Oshawa Grand Convenience located at 219 Nonquon Road. A male entered the business and made threats with a firearm while demanding cash from an employee. The suspect stole cash from the register and fled the area on foot. Officers did not locate the suspect.

The victim did not suffer any physical injuries.

On Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at approximately 7:40 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to a robbery call at One Stop Shopping Convenience located at 293 Mary Street North. A male entered the business and made threats with a knife while demanding cash from an employee. The victim used a chair to defend himself and create space, which the suspect slashed and stabbed

toward. The suspect smashed a display case and stole lottery tickets before fleeing the area on foot. Officers attended but did not locate the suspect.

Male Wanted After Stolen Vehicle Trafficking Investigation

Police are requesting the public's assistance in locating a male wanted in relation to the trafficking of stolen vehicles. Following an investigation by the DRPS Auto Robbery Crime Unit, investigators identified a male involved in the trafficking over 40 stolen vehicles.

A wanted male who was arrested by the DRPS Gun and Gang Unit is facing further charges following a firearm investigation in Ajax.

On Friday, April 17, 2026, members of the Gun and Gang Unit completed an investigation into a male who was believed to be in possession of a firearm and wanted on assault and break-and-enter charges.

Investigators located the suspect in Ajax and took him into custody without incident. Subsequently, a search warrant was executed at a residence in Ajax, where officers seized a loaded firearm with an overcapacity magazine

Oshawa residence and took him into custody without incident.

A 14-year-old male from Oshawa is charged with: Robbery, Uttering Threats. He was held for a bail hearing.

Youth Arrested for Threats with Imitation Firearm at School in Oshawa

A youth is facing charges after brandishing an imitation firearm and making threats in a classroom at a Secondary School in Oshawa.

On Tuesday, April 14, 2026, a student at a secondary school in the area of Harmony Road

was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre. The driver of the vehicle remained on scene and was uninjured.

Police Looking for Suspects After Shooting in Oshawa

Police are seeking information following a shooting investigation in Oshawa.

On Saturday, April 18, 2026, at approximately 4:30 p.m., members of Central East Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Court Street and Bruce Street. Durham Regional Police Service received multiple 911 calls reporting the sound of gunshots.

Officers attended the area and conducted an extensive search for victims and evidence, with assistance from the DRPS Drone Unit. Shortly after, police were notified that a male had attended a local hospital suffering from a gunshot wound. He was later transferred to a Toronto-area trauma centre with serious, non-life-threatening injuries.

As the investigation continued, police received a report of a vehicle with a bullet hole and shattered windows parked in the area of Harmony Road North and King Street East. Officers attended and located a second male suffering from a gunshot wound inside a nearby residential unit. He was transported to a local hospital with serious, non-life-threatening injuries.

Police are continuing to search for two suspects who allegedly shot at the victims while they were in a vehicle.

Four Arrested After Armed Robbery Investigation in Oshawa

Police have arrested three males and a female after an armed robbery in Oshawa.

On Saturday, April 18, 2026, at approximately 6:30 a.m., members of Central East Division responded to an armed person call in the area of Stevenson Road North and Rossland Road West.

The victim had attended a residence to meet a friend when he was confronted outside by two suspects. The suspects assaulted the victim, stole his cash, and threatened him with a firearm before entering the residence.

Officers attended the location and set-up a perimeter. Three suspects were arrested exiting the residence a short-time later. One male suspect remained in the residence for several hours before exiting and being arrested.

A search warrant was executed at the residence and officers seized four imitation firearms.

The victim did not suffer any physical injuries.

Three of the individuals charged were already on court imposed conditions at the time of their arrest.

Bailee CHIRCOP, a 24-year-old female from Whitby is charged with: Robbery. She was released on an undertaking.

Terry WOOLNER, a 29-year-old male from Oshawa is charged with: Robbery with Offensive Weapon; Fail to Comply with Release Order. He was held for a bail hearing.

Anthony MURRAY, a 37-year-old male of no fixed address is charged with: Robbery; Obstruct Peace Officer; Fail to Comply with Probation Order; and Possess Weapon for Dangerous Purpose. He was held for a bail hearing.

Cody GROSE, a 47-year-old male from Oshawa is charged with Fail to Comply with Release Order. He was held for a bail hearing.

Fatal Collision in Oshawa

A 40-year-old male suffered fatal injuries after a single motor vehicle collision in Oshawa.

On Friday, April 17, 2026, at approximately 10:25 p.m., members of East Division responded to a collision in the area of Adelaide Avenue East, east of Blackthorn Street in Oshawa. A 40-year-old male was driving a Toyota sedan westbound on Adelaide Avenue East when the vehicle left the road way and struck a mature tree causing significant damages. The vehicle continued forward and struck another mature tree before coming to a final stop. The driver of the Toyota was pronounced deceased on scene.

Pedestrian Suffers Significant Injuries After Collision in Ajax

A pedestrian suffered significant injuries following a single vehicle collision in Ajax.

On Thursday, April 23, 2026, at approximately 2:25 p.m., members of West Division responded to a pedestrian involved collision in the area of Harwood Avenue North and Rossland Road East. A Mini Cooper was travelling southbound on Harwood Avenue North when it collided with a female pedestrian in the roadway.

As a result of the collision, the 16-year-old female pedestrian suffered significant injuries and was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre. The 48-year-old male driver of the Mini remained on scene.

Male Wanted After Auto Theft Investigation

Police are requesting the public's assistance in locating a male wanted in relation to the trafficking of stolen vehicles.

Members of the DRPS Auto Robbery Crime Unit have identified a male involved in organized auto theft in the Greater Toronto Area. The accused resides in Quebec, but would travel to Ontario to steal vehicles for the purpose of trafficking.

Nicholas BLANCHETTE, age 23 from Quebec is wanted for: Theft of Motor Vehicle, Traffic in Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000 x3, Possession of Property Obtained by Crime Over \$5000 for the Purpose of Trafficking x3, Conspiracy to Commit an Indictable Offence, and Fail to Comply with Probation Order.

Wanted Male Arrested Following Firearm Investigation in Ajax

Youth Arrested After Robbery at High School in Oshawa

A male youth is facing charges after a robbery at a high school in Oshawa.

On Thursday, April 16, 2026, at approximately 1:45 p.m., members of the East Division Community Resource Unit (CRU) responded to a robbery call at a high school in the area of Harmony Road North and Adelaide Avenue East. A male student approached the victim when he exited class and made threats while demanding the victim's phone and property. The suspect was confronted by school staff but fled the area on foot.

The victim did not suffer any physical injuries.

A short time later, officers located the suspect at an

North and Coldstream Drive brandished a firearm during class and made threats to fellow students.

On Wednesday, April 15, 2026, after further investigation, the youth surrendered himself to investigators at East Division. Officers seized the imitation firearm used during the incident.

A 14-year-old from Oshawa is charged with: Possess Weapon Dangerous, and Uttering Threats. They were released on an Undertaking.

Pedestrian Suffers Life-Threatening Injuries in Pickering

A pedestrian suffered life-threatening injuries following a single vehicle collision in Pickering.

On Tuesday, April 21, 2026, at approximately 1:25 p.m., members of West Division responded to a pedestrian involved collision in the area of Brock Road and Dellbrook Avenue. A Nissan SUV was travelling northbound on Brock Road when it collided with a female pedestrian in the roadway.

As a result of the collision, the female pedestrian suffered life-threatening injuries and
