SUSPECT IDENTIFIED IN PICKERING SHOOTING

Police have identified a 33year-old male suspect wanted after a shooting in Pickering left two people in hospital with serious injuries.

On Saturday, August 16, 2025, at approximately 1:10 a.m., members from West Division were called to a parking lot in the area of Liverpool Road and Kingston Road for reports of shots being fired. Officers arrived on scene and located two people suffering from gunshot wounds. Both victims were transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre.

Mahiban PERIN-BANATHAN, age 33, of Bradford is wanted for multioffences, including:

Assault Aggravated x2; Weapon Possess Dangerous to Public Peace and Discharge Firearm with Intent to Wound.

He is considered armed and dangerous. If you see this male, do not approach and call 9-1-1.

TWO **SUSPECTS WANTED AFTER ATTEMPT ARSON IN** CLARINGTON

Police are searching for two suspects after an attempted arson Saturday morning in Clarington.

On Saturday, September 6, 2025, members of East Division responded to a business in the area of Baseline Road West and Cigas Road after the business owner located two incendiary devices on the property. Officers attended and located two bottles filled with an ignitable substance. Video surveillance shows two suspects arriving and attempting to light the bottles on fire prior to fleeing the area.

The suspects fled in a white

sedan.

Suspect #1 is described as: male, wearing a grey hooded sweatshirt and black pants. Suspect #2 is described as: male, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt.

MALE IN CUSTODY AFTER STABBING IN **AJAX**

On Friday, September 5, 2025, at approximately 3:10 p.m., members from West Division responded to a stabbing in the area of Old Kingston Road and Elizabeth Street. Officers arrived on scene and located one victim suffering from a stab wound. The suspect had fled on foot prior to police arrival. The victim was transported to a Toronto-area trauma centre and remains in stable condi-

With the assistance of DRPS Tactical Support Unit (TSU), officers were able to locate the suspect at which time he was taken into custody without incident.

The accused and victim are known to one another and this is an isolated incident.

CARJACKING IN **BOWMANVILLE LEADS TO HOME** INVASION

Two males are facing charges after a carjacking escalated into a home invasion in Bowmanville.

On Wednesday, September 10, 2025, at approximately 9:15 p.m., members from East Division responded to a home invasion in the area of Maple Grove Road and Nash Road.

Officers arrived at the residence and the victim reported the suspect entered the garage and demanded her vehicle while threatening her with a knife. The suspect chased the victim around the garage before she dropped

her keys and ran into the house screaming for help. Her husband came to her aid and was also chased by the suspect. The victims were able to get through the door leading into the residence and close the door on the suspect who was forcefully trying to gain entry. The suspect fled in the victim's vehicle prior to police arrival. A second suspect also fled in the vehicle used to fol-

low the victim. Air1 was able to locate the stolen vehicle, along with the getaway vehicle, travelling westbound on Highway 401. Air1 continued following the vehicle and provided updates to officers on the ground. Air1 followed the stolen vehicle to a parking lot in the area of McNicoll Avenue and Mogul Drive in North York at which point the driver of the getaway vehicle enters the stolen vehicle. Members from the DRPS Project Attire Auto Theft Unit blocked the vehicle in and arrested the suspects.

The victims did not si any physical injuries.

TWO MALES ARRESTED AFTER ARMED **CARJACKINGS** IN WHITBY

Two males have been arrested after multiple armed carjackings in Whitby.

On Saturday, August 30, 2025, at approximately 4:40 area of McQuay Boulevard in the area of Renfield Crescent and Jacob Drive when two masked suspects entered the taxi and demanded the keys. The driver, fearing for his safety, exited the vehicle. The suspects fled the area in the taxi.

Shortly thereafter, police received a third call in the area of Dundas Street and Fothergill Court for a carjacking. A Lexus was parked at a residence and the driver was at the rear of the vehicle, when the suspects approached and pointed a handgun at the victim in the front passenger seat. The suspects demanded the victim get out of the vehicle, and fled the area in the taxi and Lexus.

With the assistance of Air1, officers located the stolen taxi in Whitby and took one suspect into custody. A search of the vehicle resulted in the seizure of a loaded handgun and a quantity of cocaine and methamphetamine.

The stolen Lexus was located in the area of Rossland Road conducted a search of the

suspect carrying a loaded rifle and a quantity of fentanyl. The male was taken into custody. Rhys CROASDALE, age 25, of No Fixed Address is charged with several offences including: Robbery x3; Disguise with Intent x4; Occupy Motor Vehicle with Firearm; Dangerous Operation of a Conveyance; Robbery using a Restricted or Prohibited Weapon; Point Firearm; Carry Concealed Weapon; Possession Loaded Restricted or Prohibited Firearm; Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking -Cocaine; Possession for the Purpose of Trafficking -Methamphetamine and Fail to Comply with Release Order х4
