

DRPS Launches Digital Delivery of Police Record Check Results

The Durham Regional Police Service (DRPS) is introducing digital delivery of police record check (PRC) results, improving turnaround times and providing faster, more secure access for applicants and community partners.

The online application process for police record checks remains unchanged. However, starting today, eligible completed police record checks will be delivered digitally through a secure platform, with results sent directly to the applicant's email address.

In some circumstances, digital delivery may not be possible. When this occurs, applicants will be notified by email and their completed police record check will be sent by mail.

DRPS remains committed to ensuring police record checks are delivered securely and accurately, using the method that best protects personal information.

Digital delivery may not be available if:

There are errors on the application form

A business or shared email address is provided instead of a personal email address

The results contain sensitive information that cannot be released electronically

To help avoid delays, applicants are encouraged to review the online guide outlining how to accurately complete a police record check application and prevent common errors.

Pizza Payment Scam: Bank cards switched, account drained

Durham Regional Police Service (DRPS) yesterday warned the public of a pizza payment scam that has been reported across Durham.

Police said they have received several incidents involving a fake Dominos Pizza delivery driver and customer taking fraudulent payments in exchange for cash.

Modus Operandi

The first suspect, posing as a customer, will approach you, often near a vehicle that has a fake Dominos Pizza sign affixed (see top image), and ask for your assistance in paying for their order by using your banking cards in exchange for cash. The payment is made to the second suspect, posing as the delivery driver, who will then return a similar/identical looking bank card to you, while keeping your actual bank card, police said.

Both suspects will then leave the area and immediately drain your bank account.

Both suspects are working together but pretending not to know each other as delivery driver and customer.

The suspect vehicle has been described as a grey Hyundai Sonata; however, the fake Dominos Pizza sign can be affixed to any vehicle.

Note Details And Tell Police
Police said if you are approached by unknown individuals with a similar story, please note any suspect and vehicle details and contact police.

DRPS encourages everyone to speak to their loved ones about fraud prevention and remind them that when in doubt, contact police.
